Dear Friends,

Today is the last Sunday of the Christmas season ... we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. The tradition of the visit of the magi from the east comes to us from Matthew's gospel. They come from outside of the people of Israel, indicating that Jesus' mission is open to all people. The gifts that they bring are symbolic of the three-fold nature of the Messiah: gold is a reference to Christ as King; frankincense was used for worship in the Temple, and so acknowledges Jesus as High Priest; myrrh was an oil used to anoint dead bodies, and so foretells that the Child will die to bring salvation to His people. Remember, too, that the magi announced the Good News when they returned to their native lands, reminding us of our call to be heralds of the gospel in all that we say and do. The Christmas season officially ends on Monday with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. Although this event happens many years after the Birth of Jesus, it marks the beginning of His public ministry. As baptized followers of the Lord, let us always strive to continue the works of the Lord in our charity, in our fidelity, and in our humility as we participate in the public ministry of Jesus.

I once again want to take the opportunity to thank so many people. I am grateful to our parish staff for their ministry and dedicated service to St. Luke. As Director of Music for our parish, Jessica Smith helps us to pray so beautifully when we join our voices in song before the Lord. Jessica coordinates with Loneda Jautakiene, our talented organist, to work with our parish volunteers who sing in the adult, youth, and resurrection choirs. Sr. Katherine Burke, CSJ, serves as our Director of Religious Education and is involved in faith formation for our young people and adults. Lisa Scardamaglia and the dedicated catechists of our parish work with Sister Katherine to assist parents in their primary role as teachers of the faith. Sr. Theresa Agliardi, RSM, serves our community as a Pastoral Associate. She prepares families for the baptism of their children and provides bereavement ministry to those who have lost loved ones. Together with Mary Pollini and Sr. Katherine, she coordinates special programs during Advent and Lent to help our community to enter more deeply into our faith. Of course, Mrs. Brunswick and Mrs. Mezic work with the faculty and staff of St. Luke School to provide an excellent Catholic education to the children of our community. In the rectory, Maureen Ottoson has been our parish secretary since September, and Wanda Massan and Sr. Anne Carron, RSM serve as receptionists to take care of the day-to-day needs that come up in our parish office. Ines Rios has been working as our parish bookkeeper since September. Fr. Chin Nguyen and Deacon John Kramer serve with me as parish clergy; Bishop Raymond Chappetto is retired but generously assists us in the warmer weather; and we are blessed to be assisted on the weekends by Msgr. John Strykowski and Fr. Jun Hee Lee. Callistus Ibeh is our pastoral year seminarian who has truly immersed himself in all facets of parish life. Nino Bongiorno and Mauricio Lopez serve on the parish maintenance staff; Peter Paolo and Nicolas Fonseca serve as weekend sacristans; Anthony D'Amato, Jane Cazzorla and Christine Kromer volunteer as sacristans during the week. We are blessed with many other parish ministers, volunteers and benefactors who do so much to support our parish. We are truly blessed here at St. Luke, and I pray that our blessings will continue to grow in this New Year!

Project Andrew is a program sponsored by the Vocations Office of the Diocese of Brooklyn to raise awareness about the call to priesthood. Usually one of the bishops of the diocese will join with local priests to speak to young men of high school/college age and older about their vocations. On Sunday, January 29th, Bishop Brennan will come to our deanery for a Project Andrew at St. Mel. We will gather to pray together and then share our vocation stories with young men from our local parishes before enjoying a simple meal together. Please pray for vocations ... the Diocese of Brooklyn certainly needs more men from within the local community to come forward and serve the Church as priests. The most recent vocations that I am aware of from our parish are Bishop Kevin Sweeney and Fr. Kevin Creagh, CM. It would be wonderful to see other young men from our community discerning a vocation to the priesthood. Anyone interested in coming to the Project Andrew is asked to speak to me.
