Dear Friends,

Clearly Christmas has past, but I want to express publicly in the bulletin my gratitude to Pasquale Masullo and all those who helped to construct the platform for our Nativity scene this year. I am grateful to the benefactors who contributed financially to provide the materials, and the volunteers who designed and created the platform. They did a beautiful job in decorating the Nativity once it was in place. Thanks again to all parishioners who contributed so generously at Christmas and at the end of the year. We will soon have all the contributions recorded so we can provide year-end statements for tax purposes. The clergy and rectory staff are truly grateful for all the expressions of kindness and prayers that were extended to us during the Christmas season. We are truly blessed!

Our Asian brothers and sisters are celebrating Lunar New Year this weekend. For those from Vietnam, this is *Tết Nguyên Đán*, and so we wish Fr. Chin: *chúc mừng năm mới!* In Vietnam this is the Year of the Cat, but everywhere else in Asia, it is the Year of the Rabbit ... I am a “rabbit” since I was born in 1963, which was also the Year of the Rabbit. The rabbit is a symbol of longevity, peace, and prosperity in Chinese culture, and rabbits are considered to be vigilant, witty, quick-minded and ingenious. Happy New Year everyone!

Monday, January 23rd is the annual Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. Although the Supreme Court overturned the Roe vs. Wade decision, abortion rights are now determined by the States, and so we need to continue to pray and sacrifice for the respect and dignity of all human life from conception to natural death. Of course, our own State of New York has some of the most expansive abortion laws in the country, so prayer and penance are important for us as NY Catholics.

The Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul is celebrated every year on January 25th, and it is the impetus for an annual week of prayer for Christian Unity. I am happy that we have helped to support the Food Pantry at Grace Episcopal Church. That kind of collaboration is certainly in the spirit of Christian Unity, and I hope we can promote more of that outreach in our community, especially when it comes to assisting those in need. Next weekend please bring non-perishable food items to assist with the Food Pantry at Grace Episcopal Church. Thanks to the Knights of Columbus for their assistance!

Next weekend we begin Catholic Schools Week. Here at St. Luke we are blessed to have a Catholic School that strives to form the young people of our community in the Catholic faith while at the same time providing them with an excellent academic education.
