Dear Friends,

Today is Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, and so we enter the last days of Lent: HOLY WEEK. Typically many neighbors and friends join us for Mass during these holiest days of the church year. On behalf of the parishioners of St. Luke, I welcome all visitors to our church. I pray that our liturgies this week will inspire you, and perhaps invite you to a more regular practice of your faith. The cover of this weekend's bulletin has been changed to the Holy Week schedule of liturgies to make it easier for everyone to plan their participation in the celebrations of the most sacred mysteries of our faith. I particularly highlight RECONCILIATION MONDAY, which is celebrated on Monday, April 3rd in virtually every Catholic parish on Long Island, in the five boroughs of NYC, and in the northern counties of the Archdiocese of New York. Here at St. Luke, priests will be available for confession after the noon Mass for as long as we are needed. In the evening from 6:00 to 9:00 PM the Eucharist will be exposed for Adoration while priests are available for confession. Benediction will take place at 9:00 PM. In many parishes, Reconciliation Monday is the last opportunity for confession before Easter, so plan to celebrate the sacrament to truly prepare yourself for the celebration of the Risen Lord.

There are many Catholics who regularly practice their faith but who never participate in the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. During the Mass on Holy Thursday, we imitate the example of Jesus at the Last Supper by having the presider wash the feet of several parishioners. At the end of Mass, the whole congregation joins in a procession to the Parish Center, where a Repository is set up for the Eucharist. People will come and go for visits all night; many people follow the custom of visiting three parishes on Holy Thursday night. Here at St. Luke, we conclude our period of Adoration at 11:00 PM with the praying of Night Prayer (Compline). On Good Friday, the Church does not celebrate Mass. Instead, there is a Liturgy of the Lord's Passion, during which we hear the account of the Passion from John's Gospel. There is a solemn procession of the cross into the church, and people come forward to venerate the cross with a kiss or a touch. It is a very solemn and reverent time of prayer. Then, the Eucharist is brought to the altar so we can receive the Body of Christ. The Good Friday liturgy ends in silence. On Holy Saturday, the Easter Vigil begins with the blessing of fire and the lighting of the new Easter Candle. The candle enters the darkened church: "Christ, our Light!" "Thanks be to God!" are the chants that welcome the Easter Candle, and then the whole congregation lights candles to illumine the whole church as the ancient *Exultet* is chanted to announce our celebration of Christ Risen from the dead. During the Easter Vigil liturgy, adults who have been catechized for an extended period are welcomed into the Church through the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. At St. Luke this year, one man who was previously baptized as a Lutheran will become Catholic through a profession of faith and the reception of Confirmation and Eucharist. While these liturgies are a little longer than a typical Sunday Mass, the rituals that take place are powerful and inspirational as the whole Church celebrates the salvation won for us by the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord.

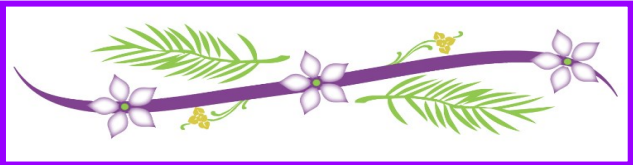

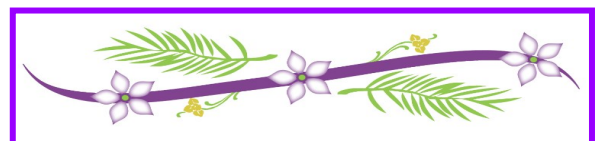

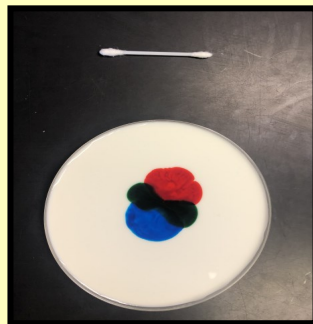


Q is for Q-tip

The students had so much fun using all these ingredients. Once they put the Q-tip in the bowl they got so excited to see what would happen next



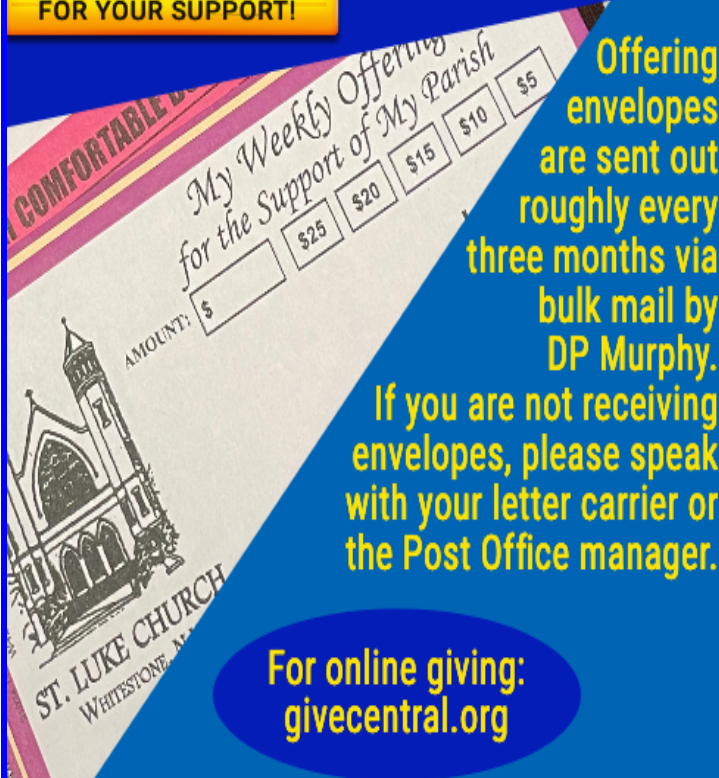
St. Luke's Class 1-2 Playing Games Again....
