Dear Friends,

***“Do not be afraid!
I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified.
He is not here, for he has been raised just as he said.”***

These words from Matthew’s gospel announce to the women at the tomb and to all disciples of all times that Jesus is truly risen from the dead. Our forty day journey through Lent is over, and now we enjoy fifty days of rejoicing that Jesus conquered sin and death through his Passion, Death, and Resurrection. Many people all around the world will be welcomed into the Church at the Easter Vigil through the Sacraments of Initiation. Here at St. Luke, Spencer Liu joined the Catholic Church through making a profession of faith and receiving Confirmation and First Communion. Congratulations, Spencer, and welcome to our family of faith!

As we celebrate the Easter season, I remind everyone that Sr. Katherine will begin a formation program for adults who need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at Pentecost. Sometimes people receive Holy Communion and never continue in their religious education to prepare for Confirmation in 8th grade. While Confirmation is not required for the celebration of Sacrament of Marriage anymore, it is certainly strongly encouraged that adults be fully initiated in the faith. This is especially important if someone is asked to be a sponsor for baptism or confirmation ... only those who are fully initiated in the faith can qualify to serve as a sponsor. If there are any adults who wish to be prepared for Confirmation, I encourage you to contact Sr. Katherine as soon as possible.

During Lent, Sr. Katherine, Sr. Theresa and Mary Pollini conducted the *Lenten Journey with Jesus* program for our parish. Sr. Theresa and Mary offered Bible Sharing after the noon Mass, and then there were five different speakers who made presentations on Tuesday evenings. It was a wonderful and inspiring program, and I am grateful to them for all their work to organize the program, and I am glad that so many people participated in the sessions on Tuesday afternoons and evenings. I wonder how many parishioners would be interested in other opportunities for faith formation like a bible study or other kinds of catechetical instruction?

Easter week is usually a more quiet week in a parish: schools are closed, so many parishioners take advantage of the break for a family getaway. We wish everyone a restful week and safe travels. I remind everyone that, since school is not in session this week, there is no 8:30 AM Mass on Tuesday and Thursday this week.

The Second Sunday of Easter is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. Next Sunday, we will conduct a Divine Mercy Holy Hour at 3:00 PM. The Holy Hour will include the singing of the Divine Mercy Chaplet and the praying of the Litany of Divine Mercy. Many parishioners have a devotion to the Divine Mercy, and so we are happy to offer the opportunity to gather on the feast day and pray with one another.
