Dear Friends,



Happy Mother's Day Weekend! It looks like spring is finally here to stay, and so it's a wonderful time to celebrate mothers, grandmothers, godmothers, step-mothers, and mothers-to-be! Of course, there are many among us who are marking the first Mother's Day without their mothers, and so we pray for eternal peace for them and all of our departed mothers. We entrust all of our mothers, living and deceased, to the tender care of the Blessed Mother.

This is a very special week here at St. Luke. Bishop Chappetto is migrating back from the south on Monday, and he will preside at the Confirmation Mass for the young people of our parish on Tuesday evening. It will be good to have Bishop Chappetto back in Whitestone, and he will be our "summer help" when Fr. Chin and I take some time for vacation. We also pray for our young people who will be fully initiated in the faith by being sealed with the Holy Spirit. May they carry their faith with them throughout their lives and develop a habit of practicing their faith regularly.

On Thursday, the Church celebrates Ascension Thursday. Forty days have passed since Easter Sunday, and the final days of the Easter season become a novena of prayer for the Church and the world to be renewed in the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. I encourage you to pray this simple prayer often between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost: *Come, Holy Spirit, come!* Pray it upon rising in the morning; pray it during you commute to work and during the quiet moments of your day; pray it as you prepare for sleep at night. *Come, Holy Spirit, come!*

Next Saturday, we have two First Communion celebrations for the children of our Religious Education program. It is always a joy to see the children come forward to receive the Eucharist for the first time. We pray that the parents, grandparents, and sponsors of the children will do all that they can to make sure the children quickly receive the second and third and subsequent Communion. Jesus is the Bread of Life, and so we all need to be nourished by the Eucharist. May God bless all of the children in our parish family!

Also next Saturday the Youth Group is sponsoring an International Dinner after the 5:00 PM Mass. Events like this are a great way to build community and teamwork among the young people, and for the community to enjoy an evening celebrating different cultures and cuisines. I am grateful to the adults who have worked with the Youth Group all year long to provide them with a variety of activities and experiences. This year has been so blessed with so many regular activities returning for parishioners of all ages!
