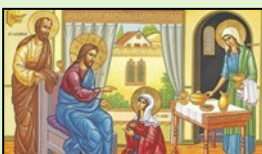
James the Great (anon)

This last full week of July brings us beautiful celebrations in the Church. First, on July 25th, we celebrate the Feast of St. James the Great, Apostle, who, as the saint to whom our diocesan Cathedral is dedicated, is one of the patrons of the Diocese of Brooklyn. This James is the brother of John, the Beloved Disciple, and the son of Zebedee. The second James among the apostles is identified as the son of Alphaeus. The name James is translated to *Santiago* in Spanish, and *Santiago de Compostela* in Spain is honored as the burial place of James and the final destination of a pilgrimage through that part of Europe that attracts many pilgrims every year.

On July 26th we honor Saints Joachim and Ann, the parents of Mary, who are also the maternal grandparents of Jesus. Pope Francis has declared their feast day as a special day of prayer for grandparents and the elderly. In 2019 he said, *“In their home, Mary came into the world, accompanied by the extraordinary mystery of the Immaculate Conception. Mary grew up in the home of Joachim and Anne; she was surrounded by their love and faith: in their home she learned to listen to the Lord and to follow his will. Saints Joachim and Anne were part of a long chain of people who had transmitted their faith and love for God, expressed in the warmth and love of family life, down to Mary, who received the Son of God in her womb and who gave him to the world, to us. How precious is the family as the privileged place for transmitting the faith!”* In our time, the role of grandparents is often invaluable in helping to raise their grandchildren. They often have the opportunity to teach their grandchildren to pray and to learn about the faith. Grandparents hold a special place in our hearts, and we pray for them in a special way, entrusting them to the intercession of Saints Joachim and Ann.

For many years, July 29th was the feast of St. Martha, but in 2021, Pope Francis added her siblings, Mary and Lazarus, to her annual celebration. The gospels record that Jesus had a special friendship with Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. He visited their home at Bethany, and he went to console the sisters at the death of their brother. Of course, Lazarus was raised from the dead by Jesus, and that became a turning point in the public

ministry of Jesus, quickly leading to His Passion and Death. St. Martha complained to Jesus that her sister, Mary, was not helping her with the details of hospitality; instead, Mary sat by Jesus to listen to his preaching. Jesus remarked that Mary chose the better part. In our parish, we have wonderful women dedicated to the *Martha's Ministry*, and they are often called upon to provide hospitality for special events taking place in our parish. We thank Lisa Scardamaglia and all the women who are dedicated to helping us build our community here at St. Luke!
