Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

As you know, Bishop Brennan appointed me the Regional Episcopal Vicar of Queens East in addition to my responsibilities as pastor of St. Luke. On Wednesday, October 4, at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph in Brooklyn, he will celebrate Mass at 7:00 PM and officially install the new episcopal vicars. I know it is a weeknight, and Brooklyn is on the other side of the world, but I invite the parishioners of St. Luke to join me in this special celebration. I will be allotted tickets for special seating, so please let me know if you are interested in attending the Mass. If you cannot attend, I am sure that the Mass will be broadcast on NET TV. Please pray for the Diocese of Brooklyn, for Bishop Brennan, and for the new episcopal vicars as we begin our ministry.

This weekend we celebrate Catechetical Sunday, and the theme this year is: "Come to Me, all you who labor and are burdened." The Lord always invites us into a deeper relationship. He loves us more than we can know or imagine, and His gift of mercy helps us to face the difficulties and challenges of our everyday lives. Learning about our faith is not just a matter of the mind, but it is also about our hearts. The more we learn about the Lord, the more we should love Him. We pray in a special way for all the children of our community. Whether they are students at St. Luke School or enrolled in our Religious Education program, we pray that the love and dedication of parents, teachers, and catechists will help them to experience the love of Jesus so that they can turn to Him to ease their burdens and bring them hope. May God bless all those involved in faith formation here at St. Luke!



Among the saint celebrations this week, St. Matthew the Apostle and Evangelist is celebrated on September 21st. Matthew was a tax collector when Jesus called him to be one of his disciples. One of the most famous artworks depicting this scene was done by

Caravaggio and can be seen in the Church of San Luigi dei Francesi, very close to Piazza Navona in Rome. Along with St. Luke and St. Mark, the Gospel of St. Matthew is known as a Synoptic Gospel, since Matthew, Mark, and Luke use some similar sources and follow a similar outline for their gospels, while at the same time also using sources particular to themselves. Matthew wrote for a Jewish audience, so many of his words and images would have been helpful to draw his readers to come to know and love Jesus from the perspective of their Jewish traditions. Two days later, on September 23rd, we celebrate St. Padre Pio. Padre Pio was a Capuchin priest who spent hours in the confessional reconciling sinners to the Lord. He also had *stigmata*, the wounds of Christ on his hands, feet and side. He died in 1968 and was canonized by Pope St. John Paul II on June 16, 2002. His canonization gathered one of the largest crowds to ever come to the Vatican for such an event. There are Padre Pio prayer groups all around the world, including here at St. Luke, and a hospital founded by Padre Pio in San Giovanni Rotondo is considered to be one of the most efficient scientific research hospitals in all of Europe. *St. Matthew and St. Padre Pio … pray for us!*


LOST and FOUND in St. Luke Church
