Dear Friends,

One of the more pleasurable parts of my new role as Episcopal Vicar is that I have the privilege of installing new pastors when they are assigned by the bishop. Beginning this weekend and for the rest of the month, I will be installing three new pastors in my vicariate: Fr. Cezariusz Jastrzębski at St. Joseph in Jamaica; Fr. Krystian Piasta at St. Bonaventure-St. Benedict the Moor in Jamaica; and Fr. Marc Swartvagher at St. Kevin, Flushing. Please join me in praying for these priests as they begin their pastoral ministry in these parishes, that God will bless them as they proclaim the Good News of Jesus to their parishioners.

Last Tuesday the priests of our deanery gathered with Bishop Brennan at St. Mel Parish for prayer, dinner, and a meeting to discuss our communities and how we can plan for the future of our parishes with the challenges of fewer priests, smaller congregations, and increasing financial needs. Currently, there are 175 parishes in Brooklyn and Queens, and 227 active diocesan priests. Of the active priests, 127 are over 60 years of age, and we are averaging only a few ordinations each year. There is simply no way the diocese can sustain all of our current parishes in the same way as the past, so the bishop is asking every deanery to assess the pastoral needs of our communities and to submit proposals of how we can reduce the number of parishes and better pool our resources for the mission of the Gospel. It seems that, with very few exceptions, every parish will be involved in some kind of reconfiguration to make better use of the limited personnel resources that are available among clergy, religious, and lay leaders. Please pray for our diocese and for our bishop.

We will start celebrating Family Masses again next weekend. We hope that more of our parish children will be encouraged to practice their faith with their families. This year, the children will hopefully be a part of processions, help with the collection and bringing up the gifts, and show their talents with crafts that correspond with the weekend's gospel. We are always looking for more parents to get involved with planning. If you are interested, please contact the rectory with your name, cell phone, and email address so we can reach out to you.

This week we will celebrate our parish feast day on Wednesday. St. Luke is one of the four evangelists who was inspired by God to write an account of the life and ministry of Jesus. St. Luke not only wrote his gospel, but he also wrote the Acts of the Apostles, which recounts the ministry of the apostles after the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. Five of the six stained glass windows in the transepts on either side of the altar beautifully depict scenes from Luke's gospel: the Good Samaritan, the Prodigal Son, the great Catch of Fish, the Healing of the Ten Lepers, and the raising from the dead of the widow's son in Nain. In both the gospel and in Acts, Luke writes to *Theophilus*, a name that means "lover of God." As parishioners of a parish dedicated to his name, I pray that all of us realize that Luke wrote for our sake, since we love God and strive to devote our lives to serving Him by serving our brothers and sisters. On Wednesday morning, the school community will gather in the church for a Rosary Rally to also celebrate October as the month dedicated to the Rosary.

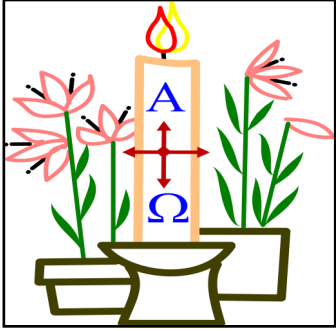
Our Church is open for private prayer from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm each weekday. Take advantage of the opportunity to spend some quiet time in prayer and reflection.

St. Luke the Apostle

St. Luke Biography

Saint Luke was born at Antioch, Syria. He was a physician and a Gentile, skilled in the Greek tongue. After his conversion to Christianity, he became a follower of St. Paul, who calls him his "fellow laborer", and "Luke, the beloved physician".

St. Luke the Evangelist

St. Luke is the inspired writer of the Third Gospel and also of the Acts of the Apostles. He was instructed in the Christian Faith by the Apostle Paul, who had never been with Jesus in the flesh, but also by the other Apostles. Therefore, he wrote his Gospel from what he had heard; but he compiled the Acts of the Apostles what he had himself seen. He is the evangelist, poet, artist and cantor of the Holy Infancy of the Savior of Mankind

He accompanied St. Paul on his second and third missionary journeys, and when St. Paul was sent to Rome as a prisoner from Jerusalem in the year 61, St. Luke attended him and had the happiness of seeing him set free in the year 63, the year in which he finished writing his Acts of the Apostles. He continued with St. Paul after his release, and the great Apostle, during his last imprisonment wrote that his other friends had all left him and that only Luke was with him.


After the martyrdom of St. Paul, St. Luke is said to have preached in Italy, Gaul, Dalmatia and Macedon. He is venerated as a Martyr, and as having suffered near Achaia, in Greece. His relics were distributed among many churches, and St. Gregory is said to have brought the head of St. Luke from Constantinople to Rome, and to have deposited it in the church of his monastery of St. Andrew.

Some of his relics are also kept in the great Grecian monastery of Mount Athos. St. Luke was never married, and lived to be eighty-four years old. According to tradition, he was a skilled artist, and several pictures of Our Blessed Lady, venerated in Rome and elsewhere, are attributed to his brush."
