The Forty Days are quickly coming to an end as we begin Holy Week. On Palm Sunday we welcome many neighbors, friends and visitors who join us at Mass as we celebrate the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord. Please see the cover of this weekend's bulletin for the complete schedule of liturgies and events here at St. Luke. If you have never participated in the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday or the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, I invite you in a special way to join us this week. They are unique liturgies that help us to properly recall the great mysteries of these days. On Holy Thursday, there is the washing of the feet after the homily, and then the procession to the Repository in the Pastoral Center at the end of Mass. On Good Friday, there is the Veneration of the Cross: everyone comes forward to kiss or reverently touch the cross as we remember the Crucifixion in a very solemn way. At the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night, we bless the fire and the Paschal Candle and celebrate Christ our Light as we celebrate Jesus' victory over sin and death. Please plan on joining us, and invite your relatives, neighbors and friends to come with you.

For many years now, the Monday of Holy Week is Reconciliation Monday. In virtually every parish in New York City and on Long Island, priests are available for an extended period for the Sacrament of Penance before Easter. Since we have a noon Mass here at St. Luke, priests are available right after Mass for as long as needed. In the evening at 6:00 PM, we expose the Blessed Sacrament on the altar to enhance the opportunity for prayer before and after people come forward for confession. Benediction will take place at 9:00 PM. Please be sure that the priests are happy to help you celebrate the sacrament if you have been away for a long time and don't remember how to go to confession. If it helps, I am providing an Act of Contrition for your use:

*O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee,
and I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments,
but most of all because they offend Thee, my God,
who art all good and deserving of all my love.
I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace
to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.*

There are many other versions of the Act of Contrition that people have learned over the years. You can also simply say: **Lord Jesus, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner**, or you can express your sorrow for your sins in your own words. The important thing is to come to confession, even if you've been away for 50 years! Draw close to the Lord and be reconciled! God loves you and wants to heal you!

Although we have no one to be baptized at the Easter Vigil at St. Luke this year, we pray in a special way for all those who will be fully initiated in the Church this Easter, especially in the Diocese of Brooklyn.

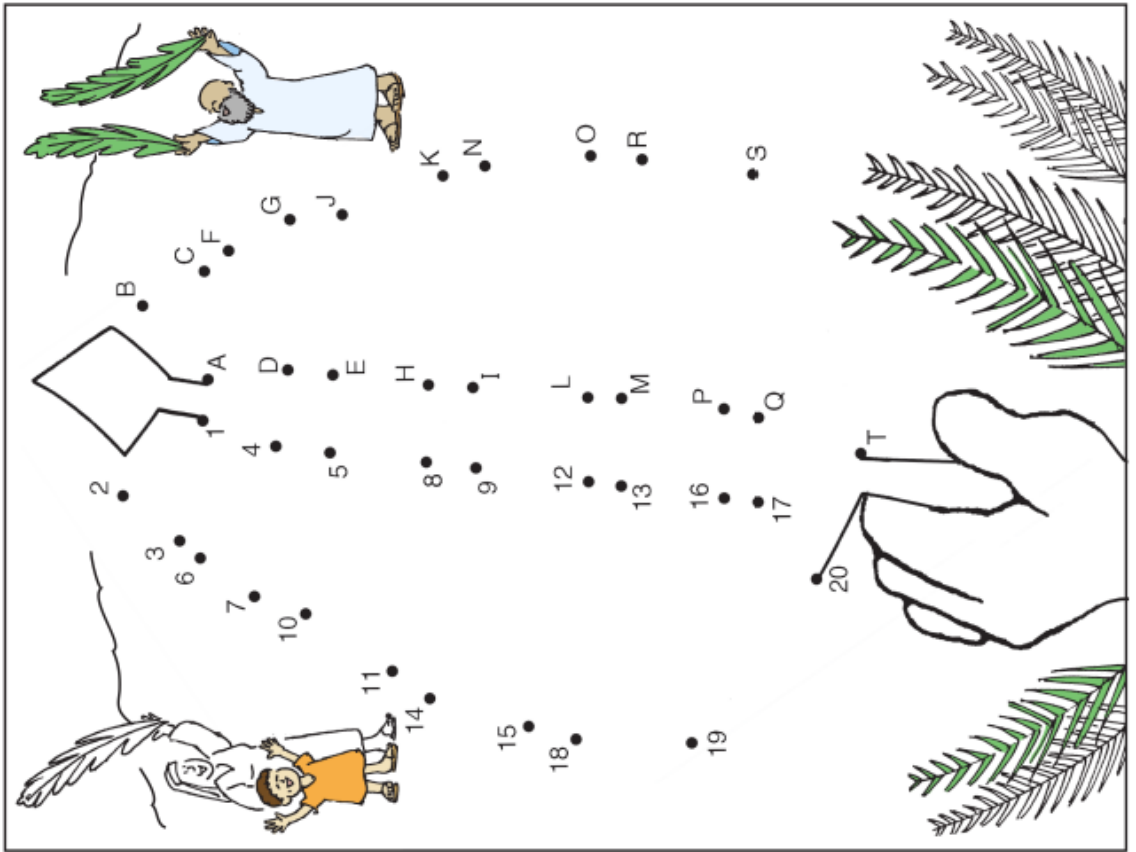
