Dear Friends,

We had beautiful celebrations for the Sacred Triduum and Easter ... over 2000 people for Easter! Of course, you couldn't ask for nicer weather for an Easter Sunday in March. Now that the Forty Days are over, we celebrate Fifty Days of Easter. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are transformed to praise, feasting, and alleluia! May these Easter days remind us of the great joy of Christ's victory over sin and death.



On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we will have a Holy Hour at 3:00 PM during which the Divine Mercy chaplet will be sung: *have mercy on us and on the whole world!* St. Faustina had a vision of Divine Mercy flowing out from the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The generous gift of God's mercy and love never ends. Devotion to Divine Mercy is a wonderful way to remember the gift of God's love made known to us through Jesus.

In his homily at the Easter Vigil this year, Pope Francis said: *“Brothers and sisters, Jesus is our Pasch. He is the One who brings us from darkness into light, who is bound to us forever, who rescues us from the abyss of sin and death, and draws us into the radiant realm of forgiveness and eternal life. Brothers and sisters, let us look up to him! Let us welcome Jesus, the God of life, into our lives, and today once again say “yes” to him. Then no stone will block the way to our hearts, no tomb will suppress the joy of life, no failure will doom us to despair. Brothers and sisters, let us lift our eyes to him and ask that the power of his resurrection may roll away the heavy stones that weigh down our souls. Let us lift our eyes to him, the Risen Lord, and press forward in the certainty that, against the obscure backdrop of our failed hopes and our deaths, the eternal life that he came to bring is even now present in our midst.”* What a wonderful message of hope for all of us!



You may have noticed a pedestal was put up in the church foyer at the main entrance. We have traditionally celebrated Mother Cabrini here for many years, and the statue that had been lent to us around her feast in November has now been donated, so Mother Cabrini's statue will soon welcome people into our church. We also have a big devotion to St. Anthony, but we don't have a proper statue of him. I have ordered a four-foot statue of St. Anthony from Italy to match the size of the Padre Pio statue. I will put St. Anthony across from Padre Pio, keeping the two Franciscan saints in the front of the church. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton will join Mother Cabrini in the main foyer. Information about memorializing the St. Anthony statue and other memorials can be found in the bulletin. [N.B. – the statue of St. Anthony may look different than the picture shown here.] I thank parishioners in advance for your generous and enthusiastic response.

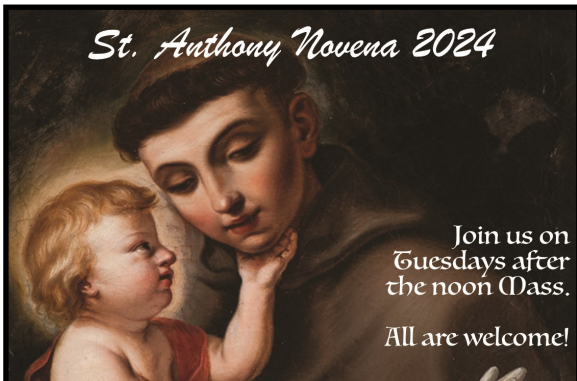

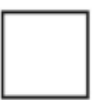

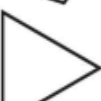
