This weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or *Corpus Christi*. This year we are in the midst of a Eucharistic Revival in the Church. During Lent, our parish hosted the Eucharistic Pilgrimage that made its way through Brooklyn and Queens. In April, the diocese hosted a major event at the US Tennis Center with Mass and Adoration. Now, our nation is preparing for a Eucharistic Congress that will take place in Indiana in the middle of July. There are four pilgrimage routes that are already making their way over 60 days to Indiana: the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Route passed through our diocese last week. As Catholics, we acknowledge the enduring presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. We believe that the Eucharist is Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity - the true presence of Jesus in the form of bread and wine. St. John

Vianney, the patron saint of parish priests, is quoted as saying, "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." The Holy Father recently confirmed a miracle attributed to Blessed Carlo Acutis, and so the Church will soon celebrate his canonization. Carlo Acutis died at 15 years of age after a brief illness, but he had a great devotion to the Eucharist from a young age and used his computer skills to create a website promoting Eucharistic miracles from around the world. We will soon acquire a statue of soon-to-be St. Carlo to hopefully inspire our young people to develop their love for Jesus in the Eucharist.

With the first weekend of June upon us, the summer is quickly approaching! We are hosting the graduation Mass for Holy Cross High School this Thursday, and many of our high school parishioners will receive their diplomas in the next week. St. Luke School will hold graduation ceremonies next week, and the last day of school is June 20th. Of course, college students have already graduated or completed their semester, and so summer routines will be upon us shortly. Looking ahead, the 5:00 PM Sunday evening Mass will be dropped from the schedule from June 30th through Labor Day weekend.



This coming Friday is not only the First Friday of June, but it is also the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The tradition of the Church is to celebrate devotions to the Sacred Heart on the First Friday of every month, but in particular this year, the annual Solemnity of the Sacred Heart falls on a First Friday. The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart, and in recent years the feast has been promoted as a Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. In your charity, I ask for your prayers for all the priests of St. Luke Parish – both past and present. Pray, too, for vocations to the priesthood. This weekend, four men were ordained to serve our diocese as priests, so please pray for newly ordained Father Luis Marquez, Father Caetano Moura de Oliveira, Father Randy Nguyen, and Father

Tobechukwu Offiah. *Ad multos annos!*
