

I am happy that we are blessing new statues for our church this weekend. We already have regular devotions to St. Anthony and St. Frances Cabrini here in the parish, but to add Mother Cabrini's statue and to have a larger and more beautiful statue of St. Anthony will certainly enhance the devotional life of many parishioners who faithfully turn to the saints for their intercession. With regard to Blessed Carlo Acutis, Pope Francis has already approved the miracle that is required for his canonization. There will be a consistory of cardinals in early July to set a date for the canonization, which will likely take place in the fall. I believe it will be beautiful and inspirational for young people to see an image of a saint who wears sneakers, khakis, a backpack with a water bottle, and

carries a cellphone. Yes, even millennials are called to be holy, to be saints, and soon-to-be-Saint Carlo Acutis is a great role model for them!

Although Juneteenth has been a celebration in our country to mark the end of slavery since 1866, it became a federal holiday just three years ago. On June 19, 1865, Major General Gordon Granger ordered the enforcement of the Emancipation Proclamation in Texas at the end of the Civil War (cf. Wikipedia). Since it is a federal holiday, the school and rectory office are closed, and Mass will be celebrated at 9:30 AM on Wednesday.

On Thursday summer officially begins at 4:50 PM. It is also the last day of classes for St. Luke School. Students who attend public school will enjoy their last day of school a week later on Wednesday, June 26<sup>th</sup>. Summer brings longer, warmer days, vacations, and an easier pace for many people. Many parishioners will go away for a family getaway at some point; others have a summer home where they will enjoy a longer break from life in the big city. While you are away, do not take a vacation from Mass! You can check masstimes.org to find Catholic churches almost anywhere in the United States. I recommend that, after locating a church on the masstimes website, you should go one further step and check the church's website to make sure that the information is up-to-date. Although as a priest I will often celebrate Mass on my own when I am away, I also enjoy the opportunity to go *incognito* and attend Mass in different places to take a break from preaching and experience the liturgy from the other side of the sanctuary.

Next weekend, Fr. JunHee Lee will celebrate his last regular Mass here at St. Luke. We were blessed to have him minister here while he finished his studies over these past couple of years. As you know, he has been appointed to the faculty of the Pontifical North American College in Rome. We wish him well as he begins his new ministry as Director of Human Formation for seminarians from all around the United States, as well as from Canada and Australia. Please God, he will help young men to either prayerfully determine that they are not called to the priesthood, or, for most of them, to help them prepare themselves according to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for sacred ministry as priests to serve the Church for many years. *Ad multos annos*, Fr. Lee!

We honor all our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, and father-figures who have influenced us in our lives. Happy Father's Day!
