As we continue to read from the Bread of Life Discourse from the sixth chapter of John’s gospel, Jesus begins to make a transition in his teaching: “*the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.*” It is one thing to speak about bread from heaven; it’s quite another to identify that bread with his flesh. Of course, this is the foundation for the Church’s teaching on the Real Presence of Jesus – body, blood, soul and divinity – in the bread that becomes the Body of Christ. Jesus makes this clear at the Last Supper, and we listen to this passage from the perspective of knowing about the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of the Lord. May our reflections on this passage help us to deepen our relationship with Jesus in the

Eucharist so that as we receive His Body and Blood, we will become more like the One Whom we receive.

On Wednesday this week, we celebrate the Memorial of St. Maximilian Kolbe. Maximilian was a Conventual Franciscan priest who was brought to Auschwitz during World War II. At the end of July 1941, a prisoner escaped from the concentration camp, and the deputy camp commander randomly chose 10 men to be starved to death to deter others from trying to escape. One of the men, Franciszek Gajowniczek, cried out, “My wife! My children!” Fr. Kolbe volunteered to take his place. Over the next two weeks, Fr. Kolbe remained calm and led the other prisoners in prayer. After two weeks of being starved and deprived of water, he and three other prisoners were still alive. The guards decided to kill them by lethal injection; Fr. Kolbe raised his left arm and waited peacefully for the deadly injection. He was put to death on August 14, 1941, and his body was cremated the next day. Pope St. Paul VI beatified Maximilian Kolbe in October of 1971, and 11 years later he was canonized by Pope St. John Paul II. ***No one has greater love than this, to lay down one’s life for one’s friends*** (John 15:13).

On August 15 we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII acknowledged the perennial teaching of the Church by declaring the Assumption of Mary as an official dogma of the Church. Another Marian dogma declared by Pope Pius IX teaches that Mary was conceived without sin: the Immaculate Conception. At the end of Mary’s life, to honor her fidelity to God’s will, the Church speaks of Mary’s dormition (final sleep) that led to her being assumed body and soul into heaven. The Assumption is a holy day of obligation. We will celebrate Mass here at St. Luke at 12:00 Noon and 7:30 PM.

Earlier in the year we joined with parishioners of St. Mel Parish to watch the movie *Cabrini* at the AMC theater in Bayside. I have access to a DVD of the movie, and so we will have a viewing of the movie on Monday, August 19th at 7:00 PM in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center. Mother Cabrini had a desire to be a Missionary to China, but the Pope asked her to minister to Italian immigrants in the United States. Her story is one of faith, strength, and humility as she remained determined to provide for the needs of new immigrants to New York and throughout the country. Please join us!
