As you know, Bishop Chappetto and I have worked together several times over the years. In our experience, during the summer when we have five weeks of the Bread of Life Discourse from John's gospel, we like to take the opportunity to use time during the homily to remind people of some of the practical aspects of receiving Holy Communion.

Preparation to receive Holy Communion is important, since we believe that in the Eucharist we receive Jesus Christ – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity – when we receive the host. Preparation includes regular confession, especially if we are aware of serious sin. Here at St. Luke we offer the Sacrament of Penance every Saturday from 3:30 to 4:30 PM, and also on First Fridays from 12:30 to 2:00 PM. Another aspect of

preparation is fasting for one hour before we receive Holy Communion. Older parishioners will remember a time when the faithful could not eat after midnight if they desired to receive Holy Communion, but the current discipline in the Church is to fast for only one hour.

The Church still teaches that there is an "Easter duty" to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, especially during the Easter season. In the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, we read: "The Church obliges the faithful to take part in the Divine Liturgy on Sundays and feast days and, **prepared by the sacrament of Reconciliation, to receive the Eucharist at least once a year, if <b>possible during the Easter season.** But the Church strongly encourages the faithful to receive the holy Eucharist on Sundays and feast days, or more often still, even daily" (*CCC 1389*).

In terms of coming forward to receive Holy Communion during Mass, the Church encourages the faithful to be unified as we approach the altar. As we approach the priest or minister, we are asked to bow reverently before receiving. The faithful are discouraged from genuflecting or kneeling to receive Holy Communion, since we all have knelt already after the *Lamb of God*. When parents are coming forward with children who have not yet received their First Communion, they are encouraged to teach their children to bow to the Eucharist before stepping aside. When the priest or minister says, "The Body of Christ," the faithful should answer, "Amen" to express their belief in what they are about to receive. Those who choose to receive on the tongue should open their mouth and extend their tongue straight (not down) to allow the host to be placed directly on the tongue. Those who choose to receive on the hand should put one hand flat on top of the other hand – usually with the dominant hand on the bottom – so that the host can be placed reverently by the priest or minister. Hands should be held high so the minister does not need to lean down to place the host in the hand. Also, the faithful should not try to grab or take the host from the priest or minister. Once the host is in the hand, the person should step aside and immediately take the host with the other hand to place it directly into their mouth before returning to their seat.

Besides receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, Eucharistic adoration is also encouraged. Some parishioners come to Mass early or stay a little later after Mass to approach the tabernacle and spend some quiet time in prayer before the Lord. Here at St. Luke, we offer Eucharistic Adoration on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30 PM, and on First Fridays from 12:30 to 2:00 PM. In the summer and at other times, we offer extended opportunities to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. By receiving Holy Communion and spending time in quiet prayer before the Lord, we foster and develop an intimate relationship with the Lord Jesus.

Our Church is open for private prayer from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm each weekday. Take advantage of the opportunity to spend some quiet time in prayer and reflection.


