For several years now, Peter Paolo has served our parish as a weekend sacristan. He graduated St. John’s University last year, and completed his Master’s Degree this year. I am truly grateful for his dedicated service to St. Luke. Also, Nicolas Fonseca worked in the sacristy for the past few years. In June he graduated from St. Francis Prep, and now he is going away to college. We pray that God will richly bless these fine young men as they move on to the next phase of their lives.

The fiscal year in the Diocese of Brooklyn runs from September 1st to August 31st every year. As the 2023/2024 year comes to an end, I am grateful for your generous support of St. Luke Parish. As you know, each parish needs to be financially self-sufficient. Unlike other countries like Italy, churches in the United States do not receive any government assistance to maintain their buildings or their property. Just before COVID, our parish was about to start an increased giving program. As prices go up, offerings tend to remain steady or go down. When our accountants submitted the first draft of our budget for 2024/2025, it showed an almost \$50,000 deficit. In order to submit a balanced budget, we had to increase the income lines for offerings and fund raising. The bottom line is that we need to increase our weekly offerings by about \$1,000 each week so we can offset a \$50,000 deficit. There are several parishioners who join me in tithing, and I sincerely appreciate your regular adjustments each year to make your sacrificial offerings to both the diocese and our parish, as well as other worthy charitable causes. If you do not tithe, I encourage you to consider the biblical precept to return 10% to the Lord – 5% to the parish, and 5% to other charities. Over the years, I can acknowledge many blessings from the Lord, and I am happy to make a return to the Lord for all the good He does for me. If you cannot tithe, perhaps you can consider another percentage? A google search shows that the median household income for residents in Whitestone is \$95,987. Tithing would mean an annual gift of about \$4,800 (\$92 per week) to the parish, and an equal amount to other charities. A 5% tithe would be an annual parish gift of \$2,400 or \$46 per week. For those who cannot tithe, can I suggest increasing your offering by \$5 per week? If 200 families increased their offering by \$5 per week, that would be the \$1,000 per week that we need to keep our budget balanced. As the summer comes to an end, I ask everyone to prayerfully consider your sacrificial giving of time, talent and treasure. May the Lord continue to bless all of us here at St. Luke!

This weekend we come to the end of John 6. After his extensive teaching on the Bread of Life, Jesus turns to his disciples when several of his listeners begin to depart: “Do you also want to leave?” Simon Peter answered him, ‘Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God.’” If we, too, believe and are convinced that Jesus is the Holy One of God, then we should never tire in inviting others to encounter Jesus, the Word Made Flesh, by joining us in the Catholic Church to listen to Him in the Scriptures and to be nourished by Him in the Eucharist.
