Labor Day weekend brings us to the unofficial end of the summer. I hope and pray that many parishioners were able to get away, relax, and take a break from their normal routines. Many of our college students have already begun the new academic year. Those in high school and younger will likely begin this week. We pray for many blessings as the young people of our community return to the routine of classes, homework, and tests. We also pray for teachers and school staffs in our own parish school, but also in other local Catholic schools, high schools, and those who work in public or other private schools. May God allow our teachers to use their gifts wisely so that a new generation of students will grow in wisdom, knowledge, and faith!

After five weeks of focusing on the sixth chapter of John's gospel and the *Bread of Life Discourse*, we return to Mark's gospel this weekend. The scribes and Pharisees were learned men who dedicated themselves to the law and Jewish teachings. Sometimes, they placed extra emphasis on human traditions and lost their focus. In today's passage from the seventh chapter of Mark, the scribes and Pharisees criticize Jesus and his followers for not strictly adhering to the Jewish ceremonial customs of ritual purification. Jesus points out that spiritual purification from *evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy, blasphemy, arrogance, and folly* is much more important than bodily purification. In the time of Jesus and in our own time, it is much easier to wash the body than it is to turn away from sin. Through our acts of penance and our celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, may we always strive to remain in a state of grace so we can properly serve the Lord and our brothers and sisters.

This year, because September 8th falls on a Sunday, we will not celebrate the Birth of Mary at Mass. As you know, we celebrate Mary's Immaculate Conception on December 8th, and so nine months later marks the day of her birth. While we might not have a liturgical celebration to honor Mary's birthday this year, remember to light a candle as you visit the statue of Mary in church or go to the grotto behind the rectory to personally express your love to the Blessed Mother on her birthday.

Over the summer we had a few special activities – we finished showing season four of *The Chosen*, we had a showing of the movie *Cabrini*, and we had a few opportunities for Outdoor Eucharistic Adoration (one time brought indoors due to weather). I am grateful to all those who helped, but mostly to those who came out. About 50 people came to see *Cabrini*, and about the same number spent at least some time outdoors with the Eucharist last Monday. Now we are ready to look ahead to the fall. We will soon start looking into providing the spiritual program for men – *That Man Is You!* We are also planning Radio Bingo for the end of September, and other activities as the year goes on. We are blessed with parishioners who are willing to help plan and organize these activities. I look forward to another grace-filled year here at St. Luke! Have a blessed Labor Day weekend!

Our Church is open for private prayer from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm each weekday. Take advantage of the opportunity to spend some quiet time in prayer and reflection.




