

It's the middle of September already ... time flies! Today is Catechetical Sunday, a time for the Church to pray for all our efforts in forming our brothers and sisters in the faith. Every parish has parishioners who come forward to offer their time and talent to serve as catechists. We have some parishioners who have served as catechists for decades; others have more recently come forward to get involved in our Religious Education Program. Catechists also assist in the formation of adults in the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA). Any adults who are interested in becoming Catholics or who would like to complete their initiation in the faith through receiving First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation should contact Sr. Katherine Burke for more

information. Classes for children begin this Wednesday, so I pray that all our young people are already registered and ready to continue their formation in the faith in this new year. On behalf of the whole parish, I am grateful for the wonderful work done by Sr. Katherine, Lisa Scardamaglia, and the dedicated volunteer catechists who serve our community so well. Of course, we are also grateful to Mrs. Brunswick and the dedicated faculty and staff of St. Luke School for all they do to assist parents in the formation of their children in the Catholic faith.

This year, the theme for Catechetical Sunday is: "Lord, when did we see you hungry?" When we hear the call to be disciples of Jesus, it is not only about our own salvation. Jesus taught that when our brothers and sisters are hungry or thirsty or naked or sick or in prison, any charity or assistance we offer to them is also offered to the Lord. Our parish regularly conducts food drives and clothing drives to give parishioners of all ages the chance to recognize our own blessings and then to share them with others who are less fortunate. I pray that the youngest among us can learn this beautiful teaching from the gospels so that they may become selfless in their desire to give to their brothers and sisters.

On Friday this week, we join our Korean-Catholic brothers and sisters in honoring the memory of Andrew Kim, Paul Chong Ha-Sang, and all the other Korean martyrs who shed their blood for the sake of the gospel. The blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church. We should always be inspired by the witness of all those who chose persecution and death instead of renouncing their faith in Jesus. Next Saturday is the feast of St. Matthew, the tax collector who left his post to follow Jesus. For those who are watching The Chosen, Matthew is one of the major figures depicted in the series. As a tax collector, he would have been despised by his fellow Jews and likely ostracized by his family. Still, Jesus recognized Matthew as a sinner who needed to be healed, and in his healing he became a great witness to the gospel in his life and in his gospel. So many of us see ourselves as being unworthy of serving the community, especially as liturgical ministers. Remember that God's grace is stronger than our shortcomings. If sinners were not permitted to serve the Church, there would be no priests or religious! If you would like to be trained as a lector or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, please contact me as soon as possible so you can attend the upcoming session at St. Francis Prep on September 28th.
