I hope and pray you had a Happy Thanksgiving celebration with family and friends. Most of us are excited to see our loved ones at the holidays; for others it can be taxing. Be sure to keep God at the center of your preparations and get-togethers over these next few weeks. We certainly need to express our thanks to God for all that we have; but we also can turn to Him for patience and strength as we anticipate stressful moments at this time of year. Jesus is the reason for the season!



This First Sunday of Advent is the beginning of a new liturgical year and a new cycle of readings. This is Year C for the Sunday readings, so we will mostly hear from our parish patron at Sunday Mass. The St. Luke window in our church depicts an angel bringing the Word of God to St. Luke, who has a pen in hand ready to write God's Holy Word. St. Luke was a doctor and an artist, who is believed to have written icons in honor of the Blessed Mother. The image of Mary at the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome is

believed to be among Luke's icons; this image is beloved by Pope Francis, who prays before the image before and after his apostolic journeys. St. Luke is the author of both a synoptic gospel and the Acts of the Apostles, and he writes to Theophilus, a name that means "Lover of God." As the Jubilee Year of Hope begins on Christmas Eve, we ask for St. Luke's intercession for the whole Church, that we all might grow in our love for God during this special year ahead.

As we turn to the Scriptures on this First Sunday of Advent, I encourage you to let the exhortation of Jesus echo in your hearts: Be vigilant at all times. You know not the day or the hour: Be vigilant. Resist temptation: Be vigilant. Turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel: Be vigilant. Stay close to the Lord during this holy season of Advent so that you can truly prepare a place for Him in your hearts.

In January we will begin a 10-week adult faith formation program called Symbolon. We will gather on Saturday mornings after the 8:30 AM Mass. The 10 sessions will begin in January and end before Holy Week; we will not meet for the two weekends during President's week in February. The session begins with a video of 30 minutes or so, and then a discussion will follow. Symbolon is available on the FORMED platform, but there is value in coming together to experience the material with others and gaining from the questions and insights that will be shared. The Knights of Columbus is asking members to participate in COR, a faith formation component, and Symbolon satisfies that request. The program is open to all. Please see the form in the bulletin. If you'd like to purchase the Participant's Guide, please indicate that on the response form.

Next weekend we will have our annual Christmas tree lighting. This year we remember Sal Colak in a special way. He was so dedicated to the sports program, to the Christmas tree lighting, and so many other aspects of parish life. May he rest in peace, and may God continue to console his family.
