On this second Sunday of Advent we are introduced to the figure of John the Baptist. We hear no word from John; instead, we are told that the word of God came to him in the desert. Luke then explains how John fulfills the prophecy of Isaiah: "A voice of one crying out in the desert: 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." "We know how sometimes our lives seem to pull us in different directions with obligations, responsibilities, and temptations overwhelming us. Advent encourages us to focus on Jesus and to listen – to create the quiet and the space to make a straight path to the Lord.

This year the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday and the obligation to attend Mass remains. God anticipated the Incarnation by having Mary conceived without sin. This great privilege not only readies Mary for the Annunciation, where she makes herself completely available to God's will, but it allows her to be the best possible Mother for Jesus as he was raised in Nazareth and ultimately made the journey to the Cross. Here at St. Luke we will celebrate Mass tomorrow at 8:30 AM and 12:00 PM. Locally St. Mel will have a mass at 7:00pm.



On Thursday this week, we also celebrate Mary as Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patroness of the Americas. If you are unfamiliar with the image, it's worth a Google search to find articles or videos describing this garment. Juan Diego's tilma with the miraculous image of the Blessed Mother has endured for almost 500 years; typically, the fibers that are found in the tilma deteriorate in about 15-20 years. The stars on the mantle represent the stars that were in the sky at the time. The image keeps a constant temperature of 98.6 degrees Fahrenheit. Mary's eye captures the image of the people in the crowd when Juan Diego opened the tilma in the presence of the bishop. The tilma even survived a bombing of the basilica

that destroyed everything near it in 1921. Beyond the tilma, the enduring presence of Mary as an intercessor and patroness is what makes this feast so precious for Christians in North, Central and South Americas. *Our Lady of Guadalupe, pray for us!*

Next Saturday the parish council has planned a Christmas party for the children of the parish. After the 5:00 PM Mass there will be cocoa, crafts, and other activities. We are also asking that they bring a new, unwrapped toy for a child in need. All parish children are welcome, and I am sure it will be a fun evening. Please see the flyer in the bulletin.

In two weeks we will welcome Deacon Callistus Ibeh back to St. Luke! He will serve as deacon and preach at the 10:30 AM Mass on December 21st, and we will have a reception afterwards to give parishioners an opportunity to greet him. We look forward to his ordination to the priesthood next June! Let us continue to pray for vocations.
