I hope and pray that you and your families had a blessed and happy Christmas celebration. This year I hosted my family here at the rectory. My nephew was able to fly in Christmas morning and then fly out Christmas evening, so it was convenient for us to gather here for our celebration so we could get him back and forth to LaGuardia. Whether you had a big gathering of family and friends, or a small, intimate Christmas, I pray that the celebration of the Birth of Jesus was a joyful time for you to remember the gift of salvation that comes to us through the Incarnation.

In the Church, Christmas is not just celebrated as a day, but as an Octave ... eight days to rejoice in a special way at the Nativity. Each day at Mass the Gloria is sung or recited to remind us of the joyful proclamation of the heavenly host of angels that surrounded the humble birthplace of Jesus in Bethlehem. This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. The gospel for today's Mass skips ahead a few years to the Finding of Jesus in the Temple. The Holy Family is surrounded by relatives and friends who support one another as a community and as people of faith.

On Christmas Eve, Pope Francis inaugurated the Jubilee Year of 2025. Every 25 years, the Church announces a Jubilee Year to remind us of our need for God's mercy and forgiveness. There is often a call to forgive debt, to free those who are unjustly condemned, and for all people to reconcile with one another in communities and in nations. Pope Francis has announced a theme of Hope for this current Jubilee Year. As events in the diocese unfold we will look for ways to participate in the Jubilee Year as a parish and within our deanery.

The Church always starts the New Year invoking the intercession of Mary, the Mother of God, a holyday of obligation. We will celebrate Mass at 10:30 and Noon on Wednesday. Let us pray that we will remain close to Mary during this upcoming Jubilee Year and take every opportunity to draw closer to Jesus, the source of God's mercy and compassion in the world.

Please don't forget our Epiphany Party next Saturday! All parish ministers and volunteers are welcome to join us for a social evening to enjoy one another and to appreciate the gifts that are shared within our community.

On behalf of the clergy and staff of St. Luke, I extend to all parishioners, neighbors and friends our best wishes for a happy and healthy New Year!
