We have officially returned to Ordinary Time, and today we turn to John's gospel and to Cana. Jesus and Mary have been invited to a wedding, and the disciples are also guests. Mary discovers that they have run out of wine, and so she brings it to the attention of Jesus. Jesus tells his mother, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." Mary says to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." Apparently, Jesus' hour has come! Six stone water jars are filled, and the water becomes wine ... not just any wine, but a superior wine to what had been served earlier in the celebration. This first miracle becomes a great sign for the guests and his disciples. Mary's advice to the

servers transcends that moment in Cana 2000 years ago. "Do whatever he tells you" is great advice for disciples of Jesus at every point of salvation history. If we do whatever Jesus tells us, we will find fulfillment, joy, and grace ... and sometimes a little bit of suffering. However, doing whatever Jesus tells us is always our path to salvation. Let us listen to Jesus not just with our ears, but with our hearts!

The Church marks important celebrations this week. On Tuesday, we celebrate St. Agnes. The name Agnes comes from the Latin agnus, which means lamb. Agnes was a beautiful girl who belonged to a wealthy family. Because of her beauty, she attracted many suitors who desired her for their wife, but Agnes chose Christ as her only spouse. As a result, she suffered greatly and eventually was martyred at the age of 12 or 13. Agnes is honored as patron of girls, as well as chastity and survivors of rape. There is an annual custom of blessings two lambs on her feast, first at the Basilica of St. Agnes in Rome, and then the lambs are brought to the Pope for his blessing. They are raised on the fields of a monastery, and their wool is used to make the pallium, a special cloth worn around the neck of archbishops around the world.

On Wednesday, we mark the anniversary of the Roe vs. Wade Supreme Court decision with a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of the Unborn. Catholics will often fast or do other acts of penance on this day, as well as spend extended time in prayer at Mass or Eucharistic adoration. I encourage all parishioners to pray in a special way on Wednesday.

On Saturday, we celebrate the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul, who became the great Apostle to the Gentiles. Often this feast is used as an opportunity to pray for the unity of Christians, since all of us are rooted in the gospels and in our relationship with Jesus. We will collect food for the Food Pantry at Grace Episcopal Church next weekend to put our faith into action and to join with another local Christian community in providing food for the poor.

Tomorrow our nation celebrates Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. The Civil Rights Movement in our country was an important period to help us to overcome prejudice and hatred based on skin color, race, religion, sexuality, and other differences that exist between peoples. In his "I have a Dream" speech the week after I was born, the Reverend King famously said, "I have a dream that my four little children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character." Tomorrow is also the inauguration day of President Trump. We pray for our nation, that we may all work together for the common good, to protect our God-given freedoms, and to give the opportunity to every citizen to achieve the American Dream to provide for themselves and to hope for a better life for their children. God bless America!
