Catholic School Week begins today as the St. Luke School community gathers for the 10:30 AM Mass. We have a wonderful legacy here in our parish ... since it was founded in 1910, our school celebrates its 115th Anniversary this year! Many generations were formed by the Dominican Sisters of Amityville; in more recent years, the sacrifice and commitment of wonderful lay teachers continue to provide an excellent Catholic education to our young people. Many of our students receive scholarships to continue their formation in local Catholic high

schools, and then they go on to excel with scholarships and achievements in college. Mrs. Brunswick and Mrs. Mezic provide wonderful leadership in our school, and the faculty and staff work so well together to form the minds and the hearts of our students. Maintaining a Catholic school is challenging in many ways, and the love and support of the parish community helps our wonderful legacy to endure.

For our Scriptures this weekend, the Church turns to the first few verses of St. Luke's gospel to give us the context for what follows. St. Luke is the author of both the gospel that bears his name and also the Acts of the Apostles. Both works are written to Theophilus, a word that means lover of God. As people who love God and who desire a deeper relationship through Jesus, we then skip to the fourth chapter, where Jesus enters the synagogue in Nazareth and reads from the scroll of the prophet Isaiah:

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
because he has anointed me
to bring glad tidings to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives
and recovery of sight to the blind,
to let the oppressed go free,
and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.

Not only do these words beautifully express the mission of Jesus as the Son of God, but they also are fitting for us to hear during this Jubilee Year. As Pilgrims of Hope, we should try to bring God's mercy and love to others – certainly to family and friends, but also to the poor, to captives, to the blind, and to the oppressed. If we are instruments of God's mercy and love to them, then they can be renewed in hope and join us as pilgrims on the way to the kingdom.

We celebrate two great saints this week. On Tuesday, we celebrate St. Thomas Aquinas, a Dominican priest and doctor of the Church who is known for his extensive contributions to Catholic theology, especially with his Summa Theologica. He also wrote many hymns, including the traditional hymn for Eucharistic Adoration: Tantum Ergo Sacramentum. On Friday, we celebrate St. John Bosco, the founder of the Salesians, who died on January 31, 1888. The Salesians are known for their work with youth, following the example and spirit of their beloved Don Bosco. On the FORMED platform, there is a 3 hour movie produced in Italy (but dubbed in English) on the life of this saint: St. John Bosco: Mission to Love.



Space is limited and early registration is suggested.


