

In the fourth chapter of Luke's gospel, Jesus is tempted by the devil in the desert, and then he begins to preach in synagogues where he is generally praised by all until he gets to his hometown of Nazareth, where he is rejected by the people. He casts out demons, cures a few people, including Simon's mother-in-law, and then he left Capernaum to preach in other towns and villages. Today, in the fifth chapter of Luke, Jesus begins to call his disciples. By the Lake of Gennesaret, he gets into Simon's boat so he can preach to the people, and when he's done, he

directs Simon to put out into the deep. Although they caught nothing all night long, Jesus directs them to drop their nets, and they have such a great catch of fish that the boats are in danger of sinking. Simon immediately acknowledges his unworthiness: "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." Instead of departing from Simon, Jesus invites him to follow: "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." Like Simon, we are all sinners, all unworthy of the Lord's call to follow Him. However, despite our unworthiness, Jesus invites us to follow and fish. Let us renew our commitment to the Lord and look for ways to be instruments of leading others to the love of mercy of Jesus.

Of course, this is Super Bowl weekend. Most New Yorkers aren't too invested in the game this year – other than whatever boxes you may have! For many, it's a fun evening with family and friends that leads to an "impromptu" day off on Monday. Hopefully Super Bowl festivities won't interfere with the preeminence of the Lord's Day in our lives as Catholics.

Friday is Valentine's Day. Many couples will get engaged this week; other couples will do something special to celebrate their love. Valentine's Day gives us a chance to celebrate the love of engaged and married couples. May the Lord bless them and increase their love for one another. Of course, some hearts ache on Valentine's Day because of troubled relationships or grief for a loved one who has passed away. We pray for them as well, that the Lord will heal their hearts and renew His love within them. For couples who are struggling, I encourage *Retrouvaille* as a means to perhaps heal a marriage that has endured the hurt of infidelity or addiction or some other painful experience. As Christians, we should never lose hope!

Lent is still almost a month away. We have begun collecting palm branches from last year so they can be burned for ashes. You will find the receptacles in the main foyer of the church. Now is a good time to think about the sacrifices we will make during the forty days ... will you given something up, or will you develop a good habit of service for others ... maybe both! Since Lent is so late this year, it gives us a little extra time for prayerful reflection to do something special for the Lord ... especially during this Jubilee Year!
