Presidents' Day brings us to midwinter recess. Many of our local schools are closed this week, including St. Luke School. I am old enough to remember when this break started as "Energy Conservation Week" in the 1970s. The custom continues, and I'm sure a number of families will get away for a winter vacation, either to a warmer climate or to enjoy winter sports. Some will just stay local and keep busy with play dates and other activities. However you spend it, don't forget Jesus on Sunday or Saturday evening!

On this Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time we hear Jesus preach the Sermon on the Plain, which includes Luke's version of the beatitudes. A few years ago, I went to the Holy Land for the second time – the first time as a priest. Since I was the only priest in the group, I had the privilege of celebrating Mass every day at all the holy places. How amazing and how humbling that was! I remember when we celebrated Mass on the Mount of the Beatitudes. There is church at the location, but it is set up with many outdoor altars so different groups can have the experience of hearing the Word proclaimed in the way that Jesus did 2,000 years ago. I remember thinking how inadequate I felt preaching in the same spot Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. As we anticipate the beginning of Lent in a few weeks, the Beatitudes are a great source of reflection for how we may choose to prepare ourselves for the 40 days. As an aside, I know several parishioners have expressed a desire to go to the Holy Land on a pilgrimage once things settle down in that part of the world. Let's pray that it might be possible soon!



On Saturday the Church celebrates the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter. At the Vatican, behind the Papal altar and Bernini's magnificent baldachino, there is a sanctuary that honors this feast with another beautiful bronze artwork by Bernini. The Chair of St. Peter symbolizes the authority given to Peter and his successors by Jesus Himself. The chair is held aloft by four doctors of the Church: St. Ambrose and St. Augustine representing the western tradition, and St. John Chrysostom and St. Athanasius representing the eastern tradition. Above the sculpture is the only "stained-glass" window in St. Peter's Basilica. The window is actually alabaster, and it depicts the Holy Spirit. The altar of the Chair of St. Peter is very special to me and most alumni of the Pontifical North American College. For many years, American seminarians studying in Rome have been ordained deacons at this altar. I was ordained a deacon there on April 6, 1989 by Archbishop John Quinn of San Francisco. As we celebrate the feast next Saturday, let us pray in a special way for our Holy Father, Pope Francis, that the Lord will continue to guide him as he leads the Church as the Vicar of Christ on earth, especially during this Jubilee Year of hope.
