As I write this, Pope Francis is still in critical condition in the hospital with signs of slight improvement. We join with the whole Church in praying for the Holy Father, that the Lord will watch over him, ease his pain, and comfort him through the tender love and intercession of the Blessed Mother. While today is the 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time, since it is the Sunday before Lent begins, it is also the feast of Our Lady of Trust. In the image of Our Lady of Trust, she is holding the Child Jesus, who points to his Mother's Immaculate Heart. May the love of Mary accompany all of us through the forty days of Lent and watch over Pope Francis.

This weekend we have our Mardi Gras celebration. I hope many families will join us for an afternoon of fun before we begin the penitential season of Lent. This year the Parish Council has been trying to provide various community events for adults and children to help build the parish family as we enjoy time together. Please show your support by attending these events!

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday this week. Please see the schedule of Masses and Prayer Services on the cover of the bulletin. The forty days of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving will lead us to fifty days of rejoicing with the celebration of the Easter season. Easter is about as late as it can be ... April 20th! [As an aside, Easter is scheduled to fall on its latest possible date – April 25th – in 2038.] Hopefully a later Lent will mean nicer weather so people can participate in the Lenten Journey with Jesus on Tuesdays, daily Mass at noon on Mondays through Fridays, and the other Lenten activities that will take place here at St. Luke or in the neighboring parishes in our deanery.

A couple of weeks ago the Bayside St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee hosted a dinner at Leonard's Palazzo in Great Neck to raise funds for the upcoming parade and to honor the Grand Marshal and the Aides. I want to express my personal gratitude to parishioners, parish groups, and local community organizations that attended the event or sponsored ads in the journal. I hope that many parishioners and parish groups will be a part of the parade on Saturday, March 29th at 1:00 PM!

This weekend we continue to read from the sixth chapter of Luke's gospel, and we hear some very familiar concepts from the teaching of Jesus: "Can a blind person guide a blind person?" "Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own?" "Every tree is known by its own fruit." Even though we can become very familiar with the teachings of Jesus, it's important to listen to them with an openness so that we allow ourselves to be transformed by the Lord as we strive to grow as disciples.

As we always strive to keep our souls in spiritual order, I ask your help in keeping our church neat and clean. Many of us receive the same mailings that provide holy cards and medals. I ask you to please NOT bring them to the church to leave them for others on the shelves in the back hallway. Also, I ask you not to leave multiple copies of novenas around the church. All of these things clutter our gathering area, and a good wind spreads them all over, creating a mess in our beautiful church. Within the church itself, I ask you to clean up after yourselves before you go. Many people leave tissues, bulletins, and other debris in the pews, and sometimes people forget cell phones, prayer books, sunglasses, and other belongings. I encourage everyone to look around your place before you leave your pew so that the space is left neat and clean for the next people who will worship here after you. I thank you in advance for your cooperation.
