# First Sunday of Lent

On this first Sunday of Lent we meet Jesus in the desert. Luke tells us he was led there by the Spirit to be tempted by the devil. Although Jesus was hungry after fasting in the heat of the desert for forty days, He was strong in the Spirit, so He easily dismisses the devil's temptations. At the end, we are told that when the devil had finished every temptation, he departed from Jesus ... for a time. From our experience as disciples of Jesus, we know that we face temptation all the time, sometimes more so than others. The devil may leave us for a time, but he will always come back to try to get us over and over

again. Lent reminds us that, like Jesus, we are able to overcome temptation when we remain close to the Spirit. Many people who try to overcome habitual sins will make frequent confessions so they can count on God's help as they face familiar temptations that have led them to sin too often in the past. As pilgrims of hope during this Jubilee Year, stay close to Jesus by means of the sacraments. Only by the power of God's mercy and the nourishment we receive in the Eucharist can we be sustained in hope!

Last weekend we had some fun events for children and families ... a perfect *Mardi Gras* before Lent. On Saturday evening, the Sports Association held their annual Mass and party to gather the children, coaches and parents for an evening of fun. Then, on Sunday, the Parish Council hosted a Mardi Gras event with food, games, and fun for many families. We were very happy with the turnout for the first time we hosted the event, and we hope that it will continue to grow in the years ahead. We are blessed here at St. Luke!
