By now many of you know that Fr. Chin returned to Vietnam last weekend to be with his family. Unfortunately he didn't make it home before his father died, but he gathered with his family for the funeral. We join in praying for the repose of the soul of Francis Xavier Bau Nguyen, and for the consolation of Fr. Chin's family. It is never easy to lose a loved one, especially when they are so far away. Fr. Chin is the ninth of ten children, and so it is good for them to have some time with one another and with their mom. *May Francis Xavier Bau Nguyen rest in peace*.

We had a wonderful celebration of Irish Heritage last weekend. Lisa Scardamaglia and so many volunteers worked very hard to prepare for an enjoyable afternoon of music, dancing, food and fun. I am so happy to see more and more of these events here at St. Luke. We have a few more events planned, including the Carnival and a Murder Mystery Dinner. By working together, I hope that we can both pray and play as a faith community.

The 2nd Sunday of Lent always brings us up Mount Tabor with Jesus, Peter, James, and John for the Transfiguration. Jesus came to fulfill the law and the prophets, and so Moses and Elijah appearing with Jesus is an amazing sign of God's plan. Peter says, "Master, it is good that we are here." We can echo those words as we continue on our journey through the 40 days, because we know that God is near and guiding us along the way.

For the first time since I am pastor here at St. Luke, we will have an adult baptism during the Easter Vigil. **Cedric Ng** was sent to the Rite of Election last weekend, and we will accompany him through the Scrutinies over the next few weeks to help him prepare for the Sacraments of Initiation. Along with Cedric, **Vincent Branciforti** and **Jennifer Gupta** are preparing for full communion in the Catholic Church, and **Luz DelAlba De La Cruz, Jessica Delgado Campanella,** and **Natalia Smith** will complete their Sacraments of Initiation by being confirmed and receiving the Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. As a community, we will participate in the fuller meaning of Easter by celebrating the sacraments with our brothers and sisters. Let us pray for them and for future adult candidates for initiation in our parish community.

While he is still hospitalized, it seems that prayers have helped Pope Francis as he continues to deal with double pneumonia. He still needs treatments, but it seems that he is making progress and responding well to therapy. This past Thursday marked the 12^{th} anniversary of his election, so we pray that God will bless him as he enters the 13^{th} year of his pontificate.



Finally, we are happy to welcome Archbishop Gabriele Caccia to St. Luke today. He is the Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the United Nations, and he has joined our Italian community several times for the celebration of Mass and for presentations afterwards. We are always glad to have him join us!
