We are glad that Fr. Chin is back from Vietnam. We continue to pray for the repose of his dad’s soul and the consolation of his family. Those of us who have experienced the death of a parent know the grief that follows. It’s a great comfort to be with our family for the funeral, but then we all begin to return to our daily routines, and the sadness can hit us at different times and unexpectedly. Please remember that our parish has a Bereavement Ministry that meets monthly, and Sr. Theresa Agliardi is available for individual

bereavement as needed.

For many years now, parish staff members and volunteers have been required to comply with Safe Environment standards, including Virtus training and background checks. Recently the Diocese of Brooklyn has entered into an agreement with the New York State District Attorney that requires yearly renewals of training and updated background checks. If you have already been through the training, you will find information available to you when you log in on the Virtus platform. Although more is being required of all of us, I pray that all of us who minister to young people will agree that it is important to provide the safest environment possible for them and for the adults who interact with them. I thank everyone in advance for your cooperation and patience.

It is a blessing for us to have six people preparing for Easter Sacraments this year: one for full initiation, two converts from other Christian communities, and three to complete their initiation with Eucharist and Confirmation. Their presence among us reminds us of our duty as disciples to give witness by our lives to the redemption won for us by the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus so that others might come to know and love Him. Let us accompany them with our prayers during their final period of preparation.

Most of us this weekend will reflect on the passage from the 13th chapter of Luke’s gospel. Jesus encourages His disciples to repent or perish and then tells the parable of the fig tree as a reminder of the importance of relying on God’s mercy. For the sake of our catechumen going through the Scrutinies, some of you will hear of Jesus’ encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well. First, her neighbors and friends are drawn to encounter Jesus through her testimony, but once they have established their own personal relationship with the Lord, they no longer depend on her.

Although the Church celebrated the memorial of St. Patrick last Monday, and our city held the traditional parade that afternoon, many local communities in the city and on Long Island hold their own parades at other times during the month of March. Next Saturday, the Bayside St. Patrick’s Day Parade will take place down Bell Boulevard. I am honored to be an Aide to the Grand Marshal, and so I hope to see many friends and parishioners joining us on Saturday at 1:00 PM.
