The traditional nine days of mourning the death of Pope Francis come to an end today, and so the more immediate preparations for the Conclave will begin. On Wednesday, the Cardinals who are under 80 years of age will begin the process to elect a new Pope. The word conclave is a Latin word that means "with a key" and refers to the Cardinals being locked in the Sistine Chapel until a new Pope is elected. Of course, with the Cardinals using the Casa Santa Marta as their residence during the conclave, the reality is not as dramatic as it was in the days when sleeping quarters for all

the participants were arranged adjacent to the Sistine Chapel. The nature of a conclave is similar to a sequestered jury: the Church wants to protect the cardinals from any outside influences as they deliberate and cast their votes for the next Pope. A key moment is the Mass for Electing the Roman Pontiff that will be celebrated in St. Peter's Basilica before the Cardinals process into the Sistine Chapel. We join the Cardinals in asking the Holy Spirit to guide them as they prepare to choose a new Pope.

This weekend students from St. Luke School received their First Holy Communion; next weekend the children from the Religious Education Program will receive the Eucharist for the first time. I will join my family in Bethpage this weekend for my nephew's First Communion Mass. Our recent celebration of Holy Thursday reminded us of Jesus' Last Supper with his apostles when He instituted both the priesthood and the Eucharist. We pray that this second Sacrament of Initiation will nourish these young people regularly until they are fully initiated with the Sacrament of Confirmation. I encourage all parents to remember that you accepted the responsibility of being the first and best of teachers of the faith for your children when you brought them to the Church for baptism. They won't receive Jesus unless you regularly bring them to church. It is sad when children tell us that they are "too busy" to come to Mass on the weekend because of sports or other activities. Make Mass a priority for your family. Spending time praying with the community and being nourished by Word and Sacrament are invaluable ways to support and encourage Christian family life.

As you know, later this month the Carnival will return to St. Luke. I am grateful to Sabato Daniele and all those who are working behind the scenes to bring the event back to our parish. Please consider being a sponsor for the event, and help us to sell 50/50 tickets to make it a very successful night. The Parish Council is also planning a Murder Mystery Dinner for early June. We've had a good number of community building and fund raising events this year. Thanks to all who are organizing these events and taking part in them. Next weekend there will be a plant sale for Mother's Day!
