Habemus Papam! I was attending a deanery meeting in Jamaica when the white smoke coming out of the Sistine Chapel chimney signaled to the world that there was a new Pope. We stopped the meeting, and we watched and waited for a while, but then I had to get back to St. Luke for an appointment, so I left the meeting but kept my phone on the live feed from EWTN. While I was caught in bumper-to-bumper traffic on the Van Wyck Expressway, the Cardinal came out to the balcony and announced

that Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost was elected and chose the name Leo XIV. I never thought in my lifetime I would see an American-born Pope, but clearly the Spirit had other plans! We join with the Universal Church in praying for our new Holy Father, that he may be the shepherd that the Church needs at this time.




For many years, St. Luke hosted an AA group on Friday evenings in the Pastoral Center. Such groups have a long history and provide a supportive community of peers who help one another through the 12 steps of recovery and sobriety. We were recently informed that the group will no longer meet here at St. Luke. We pray in thanksgiving for the many people who were able to turn their lives around one day at a time through the support they encountered on Friday evenings in our church basement. We also pray for all those who continue to struggle with any number of addictions, that they may find the help they need to overcome their addictions and bring healing to themselves, their families, and their friends. While the Friday group will no longer meet here at St. Luke, the Sunday morning group will continue.

With Fridays now freed up for parish use, I want to discuss options with the Parish Council to see how we might best use the Pastoral Center going forward. Fund raisers and other events typically held on Saturdays or Sundays might choose Friday night as an option now that the center is available. Perhaps the youth group will find Fridays as a good night for some of their events. For the time being, we will not lock any other group on Friday nights until we determine how the space might help us provide fun and helpful activities for the parish.

On this Fifth Sunday of Easter, Jesus teaches his disciples in a simple yet profound way: "I give you a new commandment: love one another." He continues: "This is how all will know you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." The message is as valid today as it was 2,000 years ago. From our experience, we know that love, forgiveness, compassion, mercy are not easy ... love, forgive, be compassionate, and show mercy anyway. It is certainly what Jesus would do!






