Although during the “A” cycle of Sunday readings we usually focus on the Gospel of St. Matthew, in Lent we read lengthy but powerful passages from St. John’s Gospel on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays. On the third Sunday we read the account of Jesus’ encounter with the Samaritan woman at the well. On the 4th Sunday, the story of the healing of the man born blind; and on the 5th Sunday the raising of Lazarus from the dead. In today’s passage, the Samaritan woman represents the people who are at odds with the Jewish people. She is an unbeliever who has been married several times. In her

encounter with Jesus, not only does she have a change of heart, but when she tells others about Jesus, they also become followers, at first because of her witness, but then because they have seen for themselves. As followers of Jesus, we never know when our witness to the faith may have a profound impact on someone else. Sometimes our neighbors, co-workers, or family members are going through some kind of struggle, and they are seeking consolation and hope. Giving witness to our faith in the power and mercy of Jesus can help those who are struggling to overcome their difficulties and put their trust in the Lord.

I want to thank the members of the Parish Pastoral Council for hosting an entertaining and successful event last weekend. The Murder Mystery brought together over 100 people who enjoyed a great dinner from **Riviera Restaurant** and had everyone interacting with one another to gather clues and try to solve a murder at a 50s prom. I am glad that we can hold such events in our Pastoral Center to bring the community together for an enjoyable time. This weekend we will have the Irish Heritage event, and I am sure that it will also be successful. We are blessed with generous parishioners who are willing to work hard behind the scenes to provide social and fun opportunities for our community.

I want to point out that we will show the movie **Triumph of the Heart** on Thursday evening at 7:00 PM in the Monsignor Tosi Pastoral Center. The movie tells the story of the Passion of St. Maximilian Kolbe, and is based on a true story that took place during World War II. The movie runs approximately 112 minutes, and is not rated, though, due to the theme of the movie, it may not be suitable for children under 13. St. Maximilian Kolbe volunteered to die in place of another prisoner at the death camp in Auschwitz, joining nine other men condemned by the Nazis. As the Church marks the 800th anniversary of the death of St. Francis of Assisi, this movie celebrates and honors a Conventual Franciscan friar who embraced the selflessness of the founder of his order. There is no cost, and all are welcome.

Looking a little further ahead, remember that **Journey, Cross and Crucifixion** will take place in our church on Wednesday, March 25th. It is a living Stations of the Cross with music and an opportunity to venerate the cross as we commemorate the Passion of Jesus. The children of the religious education program will attend, and their parents are invited to join them. We also have invited the confirmation candidates of the school along with their parents to attend the presentation. A free will offering will be collected to offset the cost and to support the work of Creative Ministries. Please mark you calendars and plan to join us!

Julia Upton, RSM, is a member of the Institute of the Sisters of Mercy of the Americas. Her current research is on the contributions of "Catholic Worker Artist" Adé Bethune to the liturgical life of the Church, currently titled *The Work and Works of Mercy: Learning from Adé Bethune*.
