On this Fifth Sunday of Lent we hear one of the greatest passages from John’s gospel – the raising of Lazarus. This event takes place towards the end of the public ministry of Jesus. It is recorded in the 11th chapter of John’s gospel, which is about halfway through the book. However, the twelfth chapter tells of the anointing of Jesus at Bethany before his entry into Jerusalem, and chapter 13 brings us to the Upper Room for the Last Supper. With regard to this third week of special gospels preparing the Elect for baptism, we recall that the first two gospels have explicit references to water. With the passage of the Samaritan Woman at the well, the theme of water is quite clear. In the passage of the man born blind, he is sent to wash in the Pool of Siloam. This week, I would suggest that the theme of water is implied. Beyond the tears of Jesus when he wept during his encounter with Lazarus’ sister, Mary, Jesus goes to the tomb and calls Lazarus by name. Lazarus had been dead for four days, but now he comes out of the tomb still bound and wrapped in cloths. “Untie him and let him go.” After being dead for four days, there was a stench; surely Lazarus would have washed himself almost immediately after being untied. It may not be written in the passage, but most assuredly the man would also have wanted a drink after lying in the tomb for four days. Once again, water quenches thirst and washes someone clean ... we are now ready to enter Passiontide.

Spring has finally sprung! I am sure that you joined me in welcoming the first day of spring on Friday after a pretty severe winter. With the first full moon of spring on April 1st, we will celebrate Easter Sunday on April 5th. Of course, next weekend is Palm Sunday, and so many people will join us as we begin Holy Week. The parking lot will fill quickly, and your regular seat may already be taken when you walk into church. While Palm Sunday can easily lead to annoyance for those who attend Mass weekly, it is important to welcome those who will join us next weekend in the hopes that our hospitality and friendliness will make them feel welcome and perhaps consider joining us more regularly. I want to point out that the 8:30 AM Mass on both Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday will be in Italian to allow our Italian-speaking community to celebrate those holy days in a more traditional way.

On Wednesday we welcome Creative Ministries as they present Journey, Cross, and Crucifixion here at St. Luke at 7:30 PM. They were here a few years ago, and their presentation allows us to see the Stations of the Cross reenacted, and then we go forward to venerate the cross in a similar way as we do on Good Friday. Feel free to invite neighbors and friends to join us on Wednesday for this memorable and prayerful event.

Our altar servers are sponsoring a Bake Sale after Masses this Sunday to help offset the cost of their trip to Great Adventure in June. We are always grateful for your support, especially for our young people who help to make our liturgies reverent and prayerful. Thank you for your generosity!
