As we gather on this Palm Sunday of the Lord’s Passion, we join the whole Church as we begin Holy Week. Today we will listen to the Passion account proclaimed from Matthew’s gospel. We recall that Matthew’s gospel was written for a Jewish audience, so he highlights the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies as he proclaims the Good News. Unique elements to Matthew’s account of the Passion include the Death of Judas: only Matthew tells of the remorse and suicide of Judas, including the return of the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders. Matthew tells of the Dream of Pilate’s Wife: she sends him a message during the trial warning him to “have nothing to do with that righteous man.” When Pilate was unable to persuade the crowd, he washed his hands to symbolically declare himself innocent of Jesus’ blood; only in

Matthew’s gospel does the crowd accept the responsibility for Jesus’ crucifixion: “His blood be upon us and upon our children.” While the other gospels mention the tearing of the temple veil, only Matthew records that the earth quaked and rocks were split, and tombs were opened. I certainly welcome all our neighbors and friends who will be joining us for Mass this weekend. This weekend is also when parishioners will make their Easter Gift to the church. Especially with the severe winter that prevented many people from attending Mass regularly, I hope that you will use this opportunity to show your support and love for St. Luke. I am grateful for your generosity.

Since many of you were unable to come to many Sunday Masses because of the snow, ice, and cold, perhaps you might decide to join us for the special celebrations that will take place this week. You will find the schedule on the cover of the bulletin, but I would highlight the following:

Reconciliation Monday – Whether you last came to confession during Advent four months ago or not since the last century, know that the Lord is ready to welcome you back with open arms to absolve you of your sins. Priests will be available after the noon Mass and then from 6:00 to 9:00 PM.

Holy Wednesday – Join us as we watch Mel Gibson’s *Passion of the Christ* at 7:00 PM. This powerful movie helps us to understand the depths of the sufferings that Jesus endured on Good Friday. It is good to experience this movie with others.

Holy Thursday – The Mass of the Lord’s Supper at 7:30 PM is a little different from our usual Sunday Masses. After the homily, we reenact the *mandatum*, the washing of the feet that Jesus did for his apostles as they gathered for the Last Supper. At the end of Mass, the whole congregation joins in a procession to the Pastoral Center where a repository for the Eucharist is set up for private prayer and visits until 11:00 PM. Some people go to three parishes on Holy Thursday night to visit the repositories.

Good Friday – For several years now, we have held Stations of the Cross for children at noon. The children of the School and Religious Education Program participate by drawing the 14 stations and reading the reflections. At 3:00 PM, the Liturgy of the Lord’s Passion is celebrated. Good Friday is the only day of the year when Mass is not celebrated. We listen to the Passion from St. John’s gospel, and there is a veneration of the cross before we receive Holy Communion. For those who cannot join us at 3:00 PM, we have Stations of the Cross with Veneration of the Cross at 7:00 PM.

Holy Saturday – At 8:00 PM, the Easter Vigil begins with a blessing of fire and the new Paschal Candle. The Exultet is sung, announcing the victory of Jesus over sin and death. The Liturgy of the Word is extended at the Vigil to help us understand how the Resurrection of Jesus is the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets. This year, we will celebrate the full initiation of one young man in our community, and we will all renew our baptismal promises before once again celebrating the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Please join us as we celebrate the greatest week of the liturgical year!
