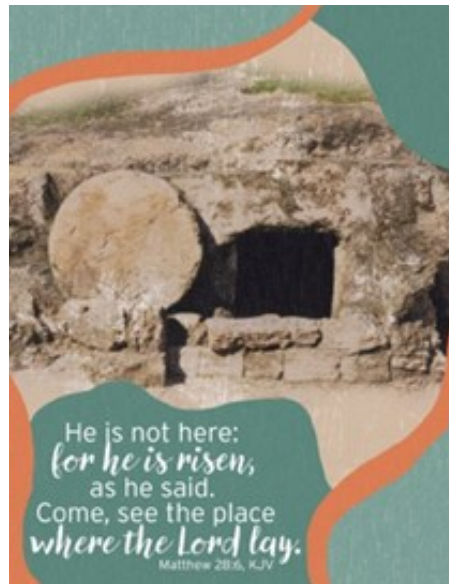

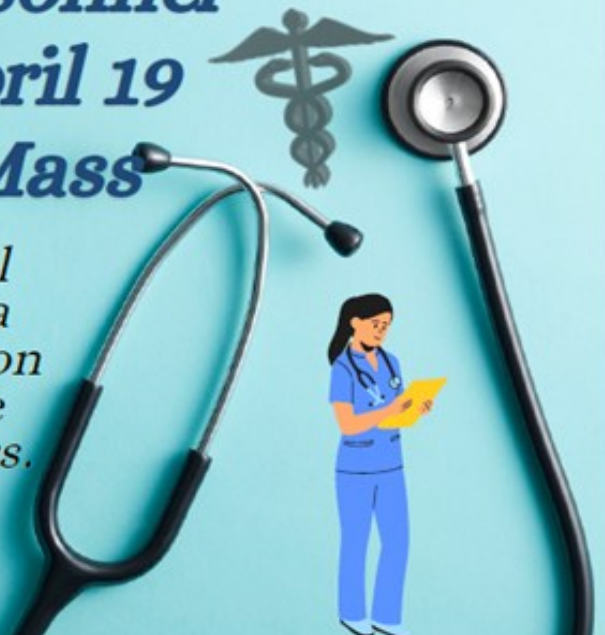

SLS BEACH CLEANUP

On March 22, students in Mr. Rau's 7th grade Religion classes who are preparing for Confirmation volunteered to clean up the beach at Powell's Cove Park with the Coastal Preservation Network. Students braved winds and a rising tide and did a great job cleaning up after a long cold winter. Well done SLS!



A Trip to the Grocery Store: Learning to Be Smart Shoppers

The St. Luke 7th grade students took a trip to their local Key Food to learn an important life skill: **comparison shopping**. Instead of just grabbing the first item they saw, students learned how to make smart choices about what to buy.

When the class arrived, they were divided into small groups and given a list of common items. Their task was to compare different brands and decide which product was the best value. At first, many students looked only at the price. However, they quickly realized that a lower price doesn't always mean a better deal.

One of the most important lessons was learning how to find the **unit price**. The unit price shows the cost per ounce or per item, making it easier to compare products of different sizes. For example, a larger box of cereal might cost more overall, but it could be cheaper per ounce than a smaller box.

Students also paid attention to sales, discounts, and store brands. Some discovered that store-brand items often cost less than name-brand products, even though they can be very similar in quality.

By the end of the trip, students understood that being a smart shopper means looking carefully at all the information—not just the price tag. They practiced math skills, worked together, and learned how to make better spending decisions.

This hands-on experience showed students that math is not just something you learn in the classroom—it's something you use in real life every day.
