As we near the end of the Easter season, we begin to hear more and more about the Holy Spirit in anticipation of Pentecost. In today's passage from the fourteenth chapter of John's gospel, Jesus tells His disciples: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth." Later this week we will celebrate Ascension Thursday, the fortieth day of the Easter Season, which leaves us with a novena of prayer in anticipation of Pentecost and the end of this holy season. We rely on the outpouring of the Holy Spirit as we celebrate the sacraments, and we ask the Lord to help us make the

best use of the gifts of the Holy Spirit as we strive to live our lives of faith. Because Ascension Thursday falls on May 14th this year, we will miss the celebration of St. Matthias. After Judas betrayed Jesus, the apostles decided to choose a replacement to collaborate closely with them as they worked at establishing the Church after Pentecost. That decision instituted the tradition of choosing successors to the apostles and gives us the opportunity to pray for all bishops as they lead the Church and preach the Good News of Jesus. On Friday the Church marked the anniversary of the election of Pope Leo XIV, the Successor of St. Peter. May God bless his Petrine ministry!

This is also Mother's Day, and so we pray in a special way for all mothers, godmothers, grandmothers ... all the wonderful women who either brought us into the world or who surrounded us with a mother's love through adoption, as a stepparent, or in any other way. While the calendar only gives us Mother's Day once a year, we know it is such a gift to express our love and gratitude to our moms any day. Some parishioners are marking the first Mother's Day since their mom passed away. May the love of Mary embrace you as you entrust them into God's merciful hands and hold them always in your heart.

The altar servers will be holding one more bake sale next weekend to raise money for their annual trip to Great Adventure. We are grateful to the children who regularly make themselves available to serve Mass on the weekends and at other special liturgies. It is wonderful for young people to have an experience of learning about the Mass and keeping their responsibilities to serve or find a replacement. We are grateful to the parents who help their children to understand the importance of loving service to the community.

Last weekend the Youth Group made an appeal at all Masses so that they can give a generous donation on behalf of our parish to the Soup Kitchen at St. Michael Parish in downtown Flushing. They raised over \$3,000! Thank you for your wonderful response to our young people. They truly enjoy helping at the Soup Kitchen and providing for those in need.
