This weekend Fr. Chin celebrates his 40th birthday on Saturday, and in a few weeks, on June 5th, he will celebrate his 5th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood. In our diocese, the first assignment of a newly ordained priest is generally no longer than five years. With that in mind, I need to share with the parish that Fr. Chin will be transferred at the end of June. Bishop Brennan has assigned him to the parish of St. Gregory the Great in Bellerose, and he will also serve as part-time chaplain at Queensborough Community College. We have been truly blessed to have Fr. Chin with us for the past five years. His ministry to the children and young people of the parish has been a wonderful gift, and his humility, generosity, and

dedicated service is a great example to all of us. We are planning a farewell Mass and reception in June so that parishioners will have a chance to express their gratitude and best wishes to him as his time at St. Luke comes to an end. We pray in a special way for Fr. Chin as he goes through this time of transition. A new priest will come to St. Luke at the end of July. Also, I was recently informed that Bishop Brennan has renewed me as pastor of St. Luke.

In this final week of the Easter Season, the Church prays in a special way for a renewal in the Holy Spirit. As Jesus ascended into heaven, he promised to send the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to remain with the Church. We are sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation, and the Spirit sustains the Church through the sacraments and by inspiring all of us in our unique call as disciples. We pray in a special way for adults who are preparing to be confirmed at Pentecost. Come, Holy Spirit!

Of course, this is still the month of May, and so we will have our annual May Crowning celebrations this week. On Wednesday evening, our Religious Education program will have its closing Mass, during which the children will crown a statue of Mary with flowers. We are always so grateful to Sr. Katherine Burke, CSJ, Lisa Scardamaglia, and all the catechists and other volunteers who help us collaborate with parents in passing the faith onto their children. We are blessed by their dedication and example! On Friday, the children of St. Luke School will participate in a prayer service and crown a statue of Mary before they take a break for Memorial Day weekend. It is important for our young people to learn about the powerful intercession and love of Mary.

On Thursday this week, the Church remembers St. Christopher Magallanes and 24 other martyrs who were put to death in the early 20th century in Mexico. Although the Catholic faith was introduced to Mexico in the early 1500s, there were periods in Mexico's history with very anti-Catholic regimes that persecuted the faith, especially priests. In 1899, St. Christopher Magallanes was ordained a priest who served his people not only providing for their spiritual needs, but also their intellectual and material needs by founding schools and opening a carpentry shop. When the government closed the local seminary in 1915, he opened a secret seminary in his home and soon had 17 seminarians. On May 21, 1927, he was on his way to celebrate Mass at a farm and he was arrested. He was falsely accused of assisting the Christeros, a group that worked to rebel against the government. Four days later, without a trial, Fr. Christopher was shot to death. His last recorded words were: "I am innocent and die innocent. I absolve with all my heart those who seek my death and ask God that my blood bring peace to a divided Mexico." Let us pray for Christians in Nigeria and around the world who even today are persecuted for their faith in Jesus Christ.
