#### Ministry to the Sick

This weekend the Church celebrates the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi. For Catholics, the Eucharist is not a simple re-enactment of what took place at the Last Supper. We believe that, through the mystery of transubstantiation, the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. The Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist nourishes and strengthens us as disciples so we can faithfully live out our call as followers of Jesus. On Saturday this weekend we will hold our annual Eucharistic procession through the streets of Whitestone. It is wonderful when we can manifest our faith

in the community and extend the blessing of Jesus in our neighborhood. I hope many parishioners, especially our young people, will join us for the procession.

At this time of year priests celebrate our ordination anniversaries. Fr. Bill, our most senior priest, celebrated his 58th anniversary on June 1st. Bishop Chappetto celebrated the 55th anniversary of his ordination to the priesthood on May 29th; he will celebrate his 14th anniversary as a bishop on July 11th. I will celebrate my 37th year of priesthood on June 24th, and Fr. Chin marked his 5th anniversary on June 5th. Together, the priests of St. Luke have served in ordained ministry for 155 years! Sr. Katherine and Sr. Theresa both mark their 59th anniversaries this year. Please pray for all of us, that we may continue to faithfully serve the Church as priests and religious. Of course, we always pray for increased vocations to priesthood, diaconate, and to consecrated life, especially from our parish. We also pray that Catholic couples will celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage to bless their union and keep them open to God’s plan for their family. We are always grateful for the blessings of single men and women who serve the Church in so many ways and enrich our community with their time and talent.

The Parish Council is planning a ministry fair for early fall. It will be an opportunity for us to encourage parishioners to serve the community in various ways, either in a liturgical ministry or by joining a committee or group. Maybe someone has an interest in an activity that might be of interest to others ... book club? painting? Taize prayer? support for caregivers? If you’d like to try to get a group off the ground, let me us know what you are thinking. While we are fundamentally a parish family, sometimes other kinds of activities lead people back to the Church because of the people they meet along the way. I hope and pray that our parish will continue to grow for many years to come.

Don’t forget that next Sunday at 12:30 PM we will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving with Fr. Chin. He came to St. Luke as a newly ordained priest in 2021, and we were privileged to play a role in his continued formation as he began to actively engage in priestly ministry. The children and young people of the parish in particular have been blessed by his presence and example, and all parishioners have come to love him as he celebrated Mass and the sacraments over these past five years. We will miss him! Please join us next weekend as we wish him well in his new ministry at St. Gregory the Great and Queensborough Community College!

# Celebrating Fr. Chin!

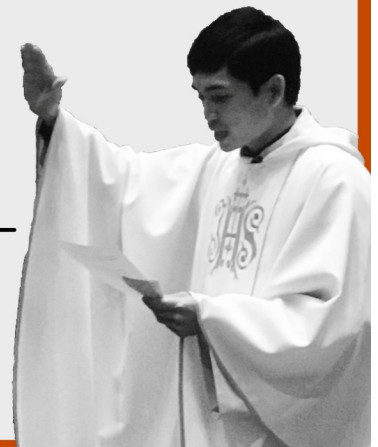
