I am glad that so many people took the time to join us for Mass and for the reception that followed. It was a great tribute to Fr. Chin, who has made such a wonderful impact on our community, particularly the young people in our school and religious education program. He will be with us through next weekend, and then he will begin his new assignment at St. Gregory the Great. God bless you, Fr. Chin!



I purposely waited until after the Mass of Thanksgiving for Fr. Chin to announce that Fr. Steven Ackah has been assigned as a Parochial Vicar here at St. Luke beginning at the end of July. Fr. Steve is from Ghana and was ordained almost 15 years ago; he has been involved in seminary formation ministry in his home country. For the past several years he has provided summer assistance in our diocese, and he comes very highly recommended. Let us pray for Fr. Steve as we prepare to welcome him to Whitestone later this summer.

Fear no one. Do not be afraid. On this 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus encourages his disciples (us too!) to remember that we are precious in the Father’s eyes: “Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father.” Since we have no reason to fear, Jesus directs us to proclaim our faith loudly and boldly: “What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.” While we might be most comfortable in our personal relationship with the Lord in prayer and coming to Mass, it is important that we live our faith in our interactions with others. At times, we may need to go outside our comfort zone to say or do what we know is right (i.e., What Would Jesus Do?), but we know that God will always provide what we need whenever we should share our faith with our brothers and sisters. Do not be afraid!

This is Father’s Day weekend, and so we pray in a special way for all of our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, and anyone who has taken on the role of a father figure in our lives. In our society sometimes fathers are absent or have limited roles in the family. When a father is present to his family, and especially when he practices his faith, he has a tremendous impact on his family and their connection to the Church and the faith. We will extend a special blessing to all fathers at Masses this weekend. Happy Father’s Day!
