On this Independence Day weekend we join with other Americans in celebrating the 250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. We pray for our elected officials, for those who serve our country, for our fellow citizens, and for those who dream the American dream, that our country will prosper, and we will always enjoy our God-given freedoms. God bless America!

Our gospel passage for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time is very consoling. Matthew 11:25-30 is an option for funeral Masses, and I often choose this passage when someone has lived to an old age, especially if they suffered at the end: “Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.” What a beautiful invitation and promise Jesus extends to us: “Come to me ... I will give you rest.” The invitation continues when He says, “Take my yoke upon you.” A yoke is a wooden crosspiece that allows oxen or other animals to work together to pull a cart or a plow. Jesus invites us to work with Him, and, of course, the wooden crosspiece points to us sharing in the cross with Jesus. The cross of Jesus always ends in His victory over sin and death, and so through our sharing in His suffering, He will set us free.

Next Saturday the Church celebrates the feast of St. Benedict. (Incidentally, Bishop Chappetto will celebrate the 14th anniversary of his ordination as a bishop on that day.] St. Benedict and his twin, St. Scholastica, were born around the year 480. He was sent to Rome to pursue his education, but he eventually felt a deeper call and fled to the mountains of Subiaco to live as a hermit. After years of prayer, others sought his leadership in living the monastic life. Several monasteries were set up under his leadership, and he eventually went to Monte Cassino where he founded a monastery that became the root of the Church’s monastic system, and his sister, Scholastica, settled nearby to live a religious life. The Rule of St. Benedict is a collection of his beliefs and instructions on religious life and still directs monastic life after fifteen centuries. St. Benedict and St. Scholastica are buried side-by-side in the Monastery at Monte Cassino.



The pace of parish life slows down over the summer, but I’d like to offer some opportunities for prayer and formation as I have in the past. I try to watch the weather forecasts week-to-week to see when it might be possible to hold Eucharistic Adoration outdoors by the Marian shrine behind the rectory. I’d also like to offer movie nights to show some films on saints and perhaps some family films that will be fun for parents with children. I’m open to suggestions. I might even be able to show films outdoors if weather permits.

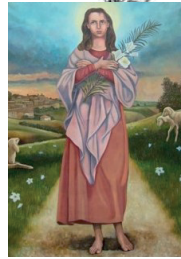

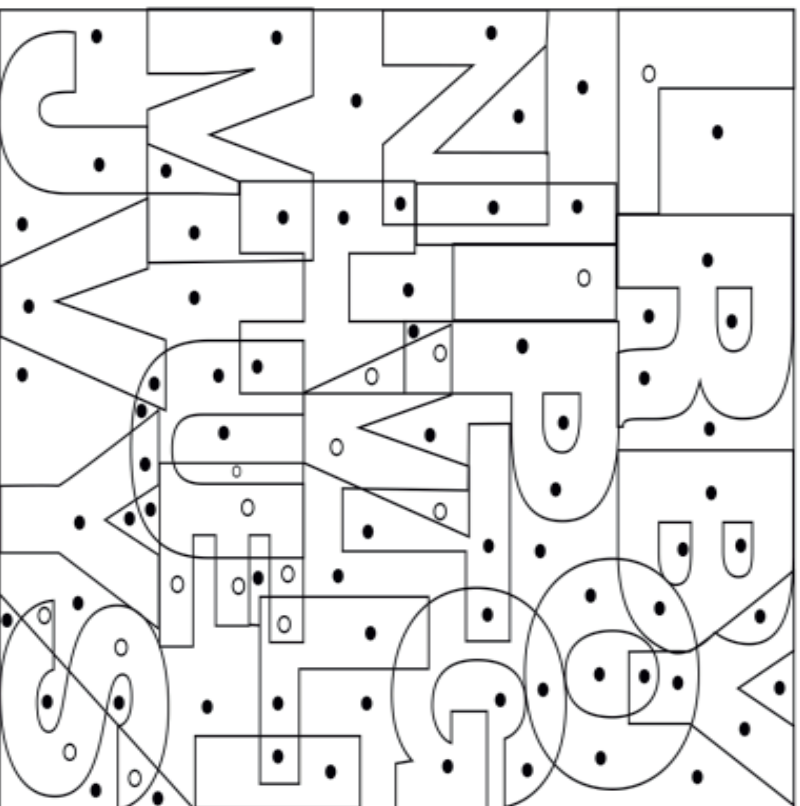

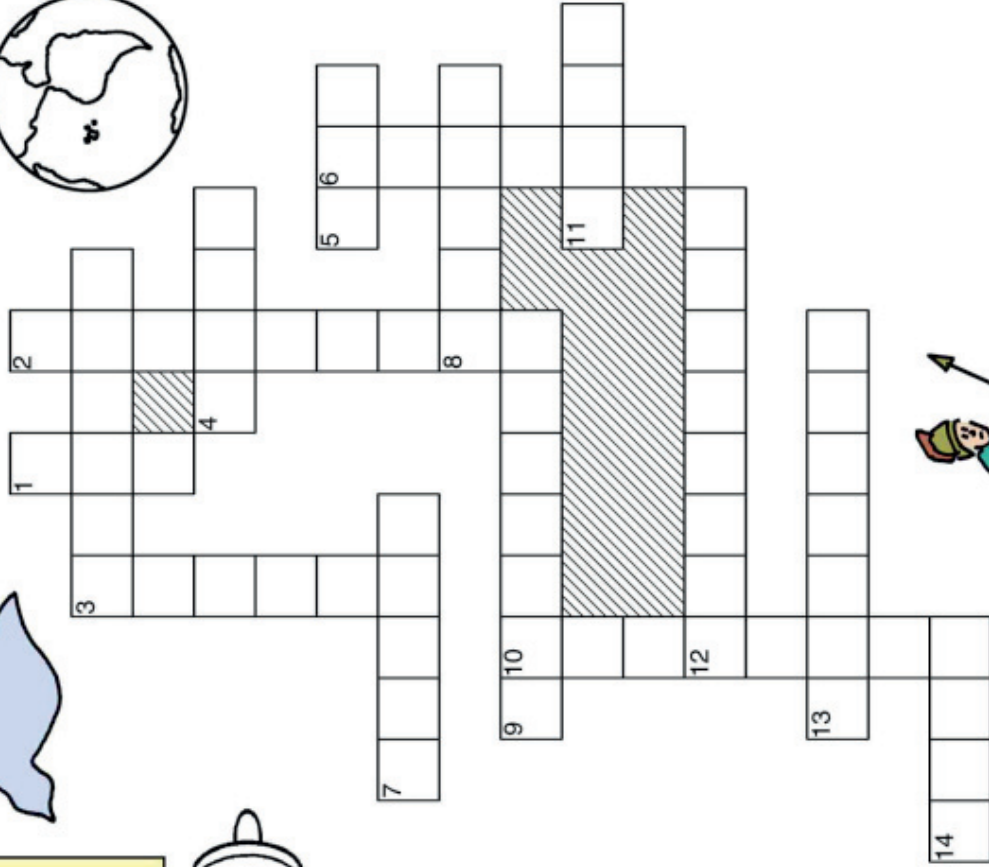
